INTRODUCTION

The Ergobaby Original Multi-Position Baby Carrier is designed for comfortable and ergonomic babywearing, supporting your child from infancy (with infant insert, sold separately) through toddlerhood. This carrier allows for multiple carry positions including front-inward, hip, and back carry, ensuring your baby is always in an ergonomic 'M' shape position. Crafted from 100% premium cotton, it offers plush comfort for both parent and child. The design includes a lumbar support waistbelt and padded shoulder straps to distribute weight evenly, enhancing comfort during extended wear. An extra-large zippered storage pocket provides convenience for essentials, and an integrated UPF baby hood offers sun protection, privacy, and support for breastfeeding.

SAFETY INFORMATION

WARNING: FALL HAZARD. Babies between 7 lb (3.2 kg) and 12 lb (5.5 kg) must use the Ergobaby Infant Insert (sold separately) with the Ergobaby Carrier, and the baby should only be carried in the front-carry position. Babies more than 12 lb (5.5 kg) but younger than 4 months or without strong and consistent head and neck control must continue using the Ergobaby Infant Insert with the carrier. Neither the baby carrier nor the Infant Insert should be used for children under 7 lb (3.2 kg). Always ensure all buckles and straps are securely fastened before and during use. Regularly check for wear and tear. Keep one hand on your baby at all times when adjusting the carrier or moving.

SETUP: HOW TO WEAR YOUR CARRIER

Properly fitting your Ergobaby carrier is essential for comfort and safety. Follow these steps to correctly put on your carrier for a front-inward carry:

- Secure the Waistbelt:** Wrap the waistbelt around your natural waist or hips, ensuring it is snug and comfortable. Fasten the large buckle securely.
- Position Your Baby:** With the waistbelt securely fastened, hold your baby against your chest, ensuring their legs are in an 'M' shape, with knees higher than their bottom.
- Bring Up the Panel:** Pull the carrier's main panel up over your baby's back, ensuring it supports them from knee-to-knee and up to their neck.
- Shoulder Straps:** Slide one shoulder strap over your shoulder, then the other.

5. **Connect Back Strap:** Reach behind your neck or back and connect the chest clip (back strap) between the two shoulder straps. Adjust its height for comfort.
6. **Tighten Straps:** Tighten all straps (shoulder and waist) until the carrier feels secure and your baby is snug against your body, high enough to kiss their head.

OPERATING: CARRY POSITIONS

The Ergobaby Original Carrier supports three ergonomic carry positions:

- **Front-Inward Carry:** Ideal for newborns (with infant insert) and older babies. Your baby faces you, promoting bonding and proper hip development.
- **Hip Carry:** Suitable for babies with strong head and neck control who enjoy observing their surroundings. The baby sits on your hip, facing outward.
- **Back Carry:** Recommended for older babies and toddlers (12-45 lbs / 5.5-20 kg) with excellent head and neck control. This position offers comfort for longer periods and allows your child a wider view.

Always ensure your baby is in an ergonomic 'M' shape position in all carries, with their bottom deep in the seat and knees at or above hip level.

MAINTENANCE

To maintain the quality and longevity of your Ergobaby Original Carrier:

- **Washing:** The carrier is machine washable. Use a mild detergent and a gentle cycle with cold water.
- **Drying:** Air dry or tumble dry on low heat. Do not bleach, iron, or dry clean.
- **Storage:** Store in a clean, dry place away from direct sunlight when not in use.
- **Inspection:** Regularly inspect all buckles, snaps, and seams for any signs of damage or wear. Discontinue use if any damage is found.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your Ergobaby Original Carrier, consider the following:

- **Discomfort:** Ensure all straps are properly adjusted and tightened. The waistbelt should be snug, and shoulder straps should distribute weight evenly. Refer to the 'Setup' section and video for correct positioning.
- **Baby's Position:** Verify your baby is in the ergonomic 'M' shape position with knees higher than their

bottom. The carrier panel should support them from knee-to-knee.

- **Fit for Different Users:** The carrier is designed to adjust for various body types. Experiment with strap adjustments to find the most comfortable fit for each wearer.
