INTRODUCTION

1. SETUP

1.2 Connecting the Console

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Console does not power on.	Power cable loose or power supply issue.	Check all power connections. Ensure the power outlet is functional.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No video output.	Incorrect video cable connection or TV input.	Verify AV/HDMI cable connections. Select the correct input source on your TV.
Controller not responding.	Controller not synced or low battery.	Resync the controller with the console. Replace controller batteries.
Disc read errors.	Dirty or scratched disc, or disc drive issue.	Clean the game disc. Try another disc. If issues persist, contact support.
