1. SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read these instructions carefully before installing and using the appliance. Keep this manual for future reference. The manufacturer is not responsible for any injury or damage resulting from incorrect installation or use.

General Safety Guidelines

- This appliance is intended for domestic use only.
- Ensure the appliance is disconnected from the power supply before any maintenance or cleaning.
- Children aged 8 years and above, and persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge can use this appliance if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and understand the hazards involved.
- Do not operate the appliance with wet hands or when it has contact with water.
- Always use appropriate cookware for the cooking zones.
- Caution: The appliance and its accessible parts become hot during use. Care should be taken to avoid touching heating elements.
- **Warning:** Unattended cooking on a hob with fat or oil can be dangerous and may result in fire. Never try to extinguish a fire with water, but switch off the appliance and then cover flame e.g. with a lid or a fire blanket.

2. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

This section provides guidelines for the proper installation of your AEG HK654070FB cooking hob. Installation should be performed by a qualified professional in accordance with local regulations and safety standards.

Installation Dimensions

Ensure the countertop opening meets the following specifications for a secure and safe fit.

- Device dimensions (Height x Width x Depth): 3.8 cm x 62.0 cm x 52.0 cm
- Installation dimensions (Height x Width x Depth): 3.8 cm x 56.0 cm x 49.0 cm
- Cutting dimensions (Width x Depth): 56.0 cm x 49.0 cm
- Minimum clearance below the hob: 12 mm (for drawers) or 30 mm (for ovens).

3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

This section details how to use your AEG HK654070FB cooking hob effectively for various cooking tasks.

Control Panel Overview

Activating and Adjusting Cooking Zones

• **Direct-Control:** To activate a cooking zone, simply touch the corresponding control area. Use the dedicated slider or the '+' and '-' buttons for each zone to select the desired heat level from 1 to 14.

- The hob is equipped with 4 quick-heat radiant cooking zones.

Special Functions

• Stop and Go Function: Press the "Stop+Go" button to temporarily pause cooking. All active zones will switch to a low keep-warm setting. Press it again to resume cooking at the previously set power levels.



• CountUp Timer: Use the integrated timer to monitor the cooking duration for each cooking zone independently. This feature allows you to track how long a dish has been cooking.

- **Eco-Timer:** This function assists in optimizing energy consumption by automatically switching off the cooking zone before the set cooking time ends, utilizing residual heat.
- OptiHeat Control: A 3-stage residual heat indicator (H/h/.) shows if the cooking zone is hot, warm, or cooling down. This feature helps prevent burns and allows for efficient utilization of residual heat for warming food.
- **Childlock:** Activate the childlock feature to prevent accidental operation or changes to settings, ensuring safety in households with children.

• Power-dependent automatic shutdown: The hob will automatically switch off if left unattended for an extended period, with the duration depending on the selected power level. This is a safety feature to prevent overheating and energy waste.

4. MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular cleaning and maintenance ensure the longevity, optimal performance, and hygienic operation of your hob.

Cleaning the Glass Ceramic Surface

- Always clean the hob after each use once it has cooled down to prevent food residues from baking onto the surface.
- Use a soft cloth or sponge with a non-abrasive cleaning agent specifically designed for glass ceramic hobs.

- For stubborn stains or burnt-on food, use a specialized hob scraper, holding it at a sharp angle (approximately 45 degrees) to the surface to avoid scratching.
- Wipe the surface dry with a clean, soft cloth to prevent water marks and streaks.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners, scouring pads, oven sprays, or harsh chemicals as they can permanently damage the glass ceramic surface.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your hob, refer to the following table for common problems and their potential solutions before contacting service.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Hob does not switch on or respond.	No power supply; Childlock activated; Control panel wet.	Check circuit breaker and power connection; Deactivate childlock; Dry the control panel thoroughly.
Cooking zone does not heat up or heats slowly.	Incorrect power level selected; Cookware not suitable or too small for the zone.	Increase power level; Use flat-bottomed cookware that covers the cooking zone adequately.
Display shows "F" or other error code.	Internal fault; Overheating; Sensor malfunction.	Switch off the hob at the mains, wait a few minutes, then switch on again. If the error persists, contact authorized service.
Hob switches off automatically during use.	Power-dependent automatic shutdown activated (safety feature); Overheating due to prolonged high heat or blocked ventilation.	This is a safety feature. Reduce cooking time or power level. Ensure proper ventilation around and under the hob. Allow the hob to cool down before resuming use.
