- Avoid placing the speakers near heat sources or in direct sunlight.
- Ensure proper ventilation around the speakers to prevent overheating.
- Use only the power source specified for this device (Corded Electric).
- Keep out of reach of children.

## SETUP

## Connecting the Speakers

1. Place the two speakers on a stable surface, ensuring they are positioned for optimal sound distribution.
2. Connect the USB cable from the main speaker to an available USB port on your computer or audio source. This cable provides both power and audio signal.
3. Ensure all connections are secure.

**Powering On/Off**

The speakers are powered on automatically when connected to a powered USB port. To turn off, disconnect the USB cable from the power source.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

### Adjusting Volume

Volume can be adjusted using the volume control knob located on the main speaker or via the provided remote control. Alternatively, you can control the volume through your connected audio device (e.g., computer operating system).

### Using the Remote Control

The remote control allows for convenient adjustment of volume and other playback functions from a distance. Point the remote control directly at the main speaker's sensor for best response.

## MAINTENANCE

### Cleaning

To clean the speakers, gently wipe the surfaces with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use liquid cleaners, aerosols, or solvents, as these may damage the finish or internal components.

### Storage

When not in use for extended periods, store the speakers in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Disconnect all cables before storage.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

### No Sound

- Ensure the USB cable is securely connected to both the speaker and the audio source.
- Check the volume levels on both the speakers and your audio device.
- Verify that the audio output settings on your computer or device are configured to use the Kinyo speakers.
- Try connecting the speakers to a different USB port or audio source.

### Distorted Sound

- Reduce the volume on both the speakers and your audio device.
  - Ensure the audio source is not sending an overdriven signal.
  - Check for any interference from other electronic devices.
