1. INTRODUCTION

This user manual provides essential information for the safe and effective use, setup, maintenance, and storage of your Sevylor Caravelle K105 inflatable boat. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the product.

The Sevylor Caravelle K105 is a compact and durable inflatable boat designed for recreational use on calm waters such as lakes and beaches. It is built with robust PVC material for longevity and features a safety line and transport handles for convenience.

Important Safety Information

WARNING:

- This boat is designed for use in calm, sheltered waters only. Do not use in strong currents, open seas, or adverse weather conditions.
- Always wear a U.S. Coast Guard approved personal flotation device (PFD).
- Never exceed the maximum weight capacity or passenger limit (3 adults).
- Do not use alcohol or drugs while operating this boat.
- Ensure all air chambers are properly inflated before use.
- Keep away from sharp objects and abrasive surfaces.
- This product does not include paddles or an inflation pump. These must be acquired separately.

2. PACKAGE CONTENTS

3. SETUP AND INFLATION

Follow these steps to properly set up and inflate your Caravelle K105 boat:

1. **Unfold the Boat:** Lay the boat out on a clean, flat surface, free from sharp objects.
2. **Identify Air Chambers:** The Caravelle K105 features multiple air chambers for safety. Locate all inflation valves (Boston and Mini Double Lock valves).
3. **Inflation:**
 - Use a hand or foot pump (not included) to inflate the main air chambers first.
 - Inflate until the boat is firm to the touch but not rigid. Do not overinflate.
 - Inflate the floor chamber last.
 - The boat is equipped with Boston valves for main chambers and Mini Double Lock valves for smaller chambers. Ensure valves are securely closed after inflation.
4. **Check for Leaks:** After inflation, visually inspect the boat for any signs of air leakage. A common method is to apply a mild soap and water solution to the valves and seams; bubbles indicate a leak.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Passenger and Weight Capacity:

The Sevylor Caravelle K105 is designed to accommodate up to **3 adults**. The maximum weight capacity is specified in the 'Specifications' section. Do not exceed these limits to ensure safety and optimal performance.

Launching and Landing:

- Carry the inflated boat to the water using the integrated transport handles.
- Ensure the area is clear of sharp objects or debris before launching.
- When landing, approach the shore slowly and carefully to avoid damaging the boat.

On the Water:

- Always maintain a safe distance from other watercraft, swimmers, and obstacles.
- The boat is equipped with a safety line around its perimeter. This line can be used for holding onto the boat from the water or for mooring.
- If using paddles (sold separately), ensure they are securely attached to the oarlocks if available, or held firmly.

5. MAINTENANCE AND STORAGE

Cleaning:

After each use, especially in saltwater, rinse the boat thoroughly with fresh water. Use a mild soap solution and a soft cloth to clean any dirt or grime. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.

Drying:

It is crucial to completely dry the boat before deflating and storing it. Lay it out in a shaded, well-ventilated area. Moisture trapped inside can lead to mold, mildew, and material degradation.

Deflation:

Open all valves to allow air to escape. You can gently roll the boat from one end to the other to expel remaining air. Ensure the boat is fully deflated before folding.

Storage:

Fold the dry, deflated boat neatly and store it in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Protect it from rodents and insects. Avoid placing heavy objects on top of the folded boat.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Loss of Air Pressure:

- **Check Valves:** Ensure all inflation valves are securely closed and free of debris.
- **Temperature Changes:** Air pressure can decrease in cooler temperatures. If the boat was inflated in warm conditions and then moved to cooler water, it might appear to lose air. Re-inflate slightly if necessary.
- **Punctures:** If a significant air loss occurs, inspect the boat for punctures. Use the included repair kit for small holes.

Repairing a Puncture:

For small punctures, use the provided repair kit:

1. Locate the leak (e.g., using soapy water).
2. Clean and dry the area around the puncture thoroughly.
3. Cut a patch from the repair material, ensuring it is larger than the hole.
4. Apply adhesive (not always included, may need to be purchased separately) to the patch and the area around the hole.
5. Press the patch firmly over the hole, smoothing out any air bubbles.
6. Allow the adhesive to cure completely before re-inflating (refer to adhesive instructions for curing time).

For large tears or significant damage, professional repair may be required. Contact Sevylor customer support.
