## INTRODUCTION

---

The Delta Children Eclipse Changing Table is designed to provide a safe and convenient space for changing your baby. Combining functionality with a stylish design and superb finish, it is an essential addition to your little one's nursery. It features ample changing space with side rails for safety, a waterproof changing pad, a safety strap, and two shelves for easy access storage of baby essentials. Assembly is required, and the product is JPMA certified.

## **SAFETY INFORMATION**

---

Always prioritize safety when using the changing table. Failure to follow these instructions could result in serious injury or death.

- Always keep your child within arm's reach while on the changing table. Never leave a child unattended.
- Use the safety strap provided to secure your child.
- Ensure all assembly hardware is securely tightened before use and periodically check for loose hardware.
- Do not use the changing table if any parts are missing, damaged, or broken. Contact Delta Children for replacement parts.
- Keep all small parts and plastic bags away from children during and after assembly.

- Do not place the changing table near windows where cords from blinds or drapes could strangle a child.
- This product is intended for children weighing up to 30 lbs (13.6 kg).

## **PARTS LIST**

---

Before assembly, ensure all components are present and undamaged. If any parts are missing or damaged, do not proceed with assembly. Contact customer support for assistance.

- Changing Table Frame (Wood components)
- Changing Pad (Waterproof)
- Safety Strap
- Two Storage Shelves
- Assembly Hardware (Screws, bolts, nuts, etc.)
- Assembly Tools (Hex key, etc. - usually included)

## SETUP (ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS)

---

Assembly is required for this changing table. It is recommended that two adults assemble the unit. Please follow these general steps. Refer to the detailed diagram in your physical manual for specific part identification and screw placement.

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully remove all parts from the packaging. Lay them out on a soft, clean surface to prevent scratches.
2. **Attach Side Panels:** Connect the side panels to the back panel using the provided hardware. Ensure all connections are snug but do not overtighten initially.
3. **Install Shelves:** Slide the two storage shelves into their designated slots or attach them to the frame using the appropriate hardware.
4. **Attach Front Panel:** Secure the front panel to complete the main frame of the changing table.

5. **Tighten All Hardware:** Once the frame is fully assembled, go back and securely tighten all screws and bolts. Do not overtighten to avoid stripping.
6. **Place Changing Pad:** Position the waterproof changing pad securely on the top surface of the table.
7. **Attach Safety Strap:** Secure the safety strap to the changing table as per the instructions to ensure it can be used to safely secure your child.
8. **Final Check:** Before first use, ensure the changing table is stable, all parts are correctly assembled, and all hardware is tight.

## OPERATING

Using your Delta Children Eclipse Changing Table is straightforward, but always remember the safety guidelines.

1. **Prepare the Area:** Before placing your baby on the table, ensure you have all necessary changing supplies (diapers, wipes, cream, fresh clothes) within easy reach on the shelves or nearby.
2. **Place Baby:** Gently place your baby on the changing pad.
3. **Secure Baby:** Fasten the safety strap around your baby. This is a secondary safety measure and does not replace constant supervision.
4. **Perform Change:** Proceed with changing your baby. Maintain one hand on your baby at all times.
5. **Remove Baby:** Once finished, unfasten the safety strap and carefully lift your baby from the table.
6. **Clean Up:** Dispose of soiled items and clean the changing pad if necessary.

## MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance will ensure the longevity and safety of your changing table.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe down the changing table and pad with a damp cloth. For stubborn stains, a mild soap solution can be used, followed by wiping with a clean, damp cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals, as they may damage the finish.
- **Regular Checks:** Periodically inspect all screws, bolts, and other hardware to ensure they are tight. Retighten if necessary, but do not overtighten.
- **Storage:** If storing the changing table for an extended period, ensure it is clean and dry. Store in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight or extreme temperatures.
- **Damage:** If any part of the changing table becomes damaged, cracked, or broken, discontinue use immediately and contact Delta Children for replacement parts. Do not attempt to repair damaged parts yourself.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

Here are some common issues and their potential solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Table is wobbly or unstable.	Loose hardware; uneven floor.	Ensure all screws and bolts are securely tightened. Move to a flat, level surface.
Parts do not fit during assembly.	Incorrect orientation of parts; manufacturing defect.	Double-check the assembly diagram. If parts are clearly misaligned or damaged, contact Delta Children customer service.
Changing pad slides.	Not properly seated; missing anti-slip features.	Ensure the changing pad is fully seated within the top rails. If it continues to slide, consider adding non-slip matting underneath (ensure it does not interfere with safety features).
