1. Introduction

Welcome to your Oatey 42251 Bathroom Sink and Tub Drain Strainer. 3. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

3.1 Before Installation

- Ensure the drain opening in your sink or tub is clean and free of any old sealant or debris.
- Verify that the drain size (2-inch or 3-inch) is compatible with the Oatey 42251 strainer.
- Gather necessary tools, which may include plumber's putty or silicone sealant, and a screwdriver if your specific installation requires it.

3.2 Installation Steps

- 1. Apply a continuous bead of plumber's putty or silicone sealant around the underside of the strainer's top flange. This creates a watertight seal.
- 2. Insert the strainer body into the drain opening from the top of the sink or tub. Press down firmly to seat it into the sealant.
- 3. From underneath the sink or tub, attach the rubber washer, friction washer, and securing nut onto the threaded portion of the strainer body.
- 4. Hand-tighten the securing nut, then use a wrench to tighten it firmly. Avoid overtightening, which can damage the drain or strainer.
- 5. Wipe away any excess plumber's putty or sealant that squeezes out from around the flange.
- 6. Place the removable grate into the strainer body.

4. OPERATION

4.1 Basic Use

The Oatey 42251 drain strainer is designed to prevent larger debris, such as hair, soap scum, and small objects, from entering and clogging your sink or tub drain. Water will flow freely through the grate while solid particles are retained on top.

4.2 Removable Grate

The grate is designed to be easily removable for routine cleaning and to provide access to the drain opening. Simply lift the grate to remove it and place it back when finished.

5. MAINTENANCE

5.1 Regular Cleaning

- Periodically remove the grate and clear any accumulated hair, soap residue, or debris.
- Clean the grate and the inside of the strainer body with a mild household cleaner and a soft brush or cloth.
- Rinse all components thoroughly with water before reassembling.
- Reinsert the grate into the strainer body.

5.2 Preventing Clogs

While the strainer is effective, avoid pouring grease, large food particles, or harsh chemicals down the drain, as these can still lead to clogs further down the plumbing system or damage the product over time.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

6.1 Slow Drainage

• Issue: Water drains slowly through the strainer.

• **Solution:** Remove the grate and check for accumulated hair or debris within the strainer body or just below it. Clean thoroughly. If the issue persists after cleaning the strainer, the clog may be further down the plumbing system, potentially requiring a drain cleaner or professional assistance.

6.2 Leaks Around Strainer

- Issue: Water is leaking from around the strainer flange where it meets the sink or tub.
- **Solution:** This indicates an improper seal. Disassemble the strainer, clean the area thoroughly, reapply plumber's putty or silicone sealant around the flange, and re-tighten the securing nut from underneath. Ensure the sealant forms a complete and even barrier.
