INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the proper use and care of your Timex Men's Originals 42mm Watch, model T2N6779J. Please read these instructions carefully to ensure optimal performance and longevity of your timepiece.

SETUP

1. Setting the Time

To set the time on your watch:

1. Gently pull the crown (the small knob on the side of the watch case) outwards to the time-setting position.
2. Rotate the crown in either direction until the hour and minute hands display the correct time.
3. Once the time is set, push the crown back into its original position to engage the movement and start the watch.

2. Adjusting the Strap

The genuine leather strap is adjustable to fit various wrist sizes. Use the buckle to select the appropriate hole for a comfortable and secure fit. The strap is designed to fit wrist circumferences up to 8 inches.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Indiglo Light-Up Dial

Your Timex watch features the Indiglo night-light function for illumination in low-light conditions. To activate the Indiglo light, simply press and hold the crown. The dial will illuminate with a soft, even glow. Release the crown to turn off the light.

2. Water Resistance

This watch is water resistant to 30 meters (100 feet). This rating means the watch is suitable for splashes or brief immersion in water. It is **not** suitable for swimming, bathing, showering, or diving. Exposure to hot water or steam may damage the watch.

Maintenance

1. Cleaning

Wipe the watch case and crystal with a soft, dry cloth. For the leather strap, avoid excessive moisture. If the strap becomes wet, allow it to air dry naturally, away from direct heat or sunlight.

2. Battery Replacement

The watch uses one LR44 battery. When the battery needs replacement, it is recommended to have it replaced by a qualified watch technician or an authorized Timex service center. This ensures proper sealing for water resistance and prevents damage to the movement.

3. Strap Care

The genuine leather strap may show signs of wear over time. To prolong its life, avoid prolonged exposure to water, direct sunlight, and harsh chemicals. If the strap needs replacement, ensure you use a 20mm strap compatible with your watch model.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- Watch Not Running:** Ensure the crown is fully pushed in. If it is, the battery may need replacement.
- Indiglo Not Working:** Check if the crown is being pressed firmly. If the light remains unresponsive, the battery may be low or depleted.
- Inaccurate Time:** If the watch is consistently losing or gaining time, the battery may be weak, or the movement may require inspection by a professional.


