# Gioteck VX1 Wireless Controller User Manual

#### 1. Introduction

The Gioteck VX1 Wireless Controller is designed for use with PlayStation 3 consoles, offering an enhanced gaming experience through its ergonomic design and advanced features. This manual provides comprehensive instructions for setting up, operating, maintaining, and troubleshooting your VX1 controller.

## 2. KEY FEATURES

- 2.4GHz Wireless Connection: Provides a lag-free wireless signal for flexible gameplay. A USB dongle is included for connectivity.
- Ergonomic Styling with Rubberized Handles: Designed for comfort during extended gaming sessions, featuring a tactile silk finish and weighted handles.
- Contoured Action Buttons: Positioned for optimal thumb rotation and quick access.
- Concave Anti-Slip Rubber Thumbstick Grips: Reduces slippage and enhances rotational precision during intense gameplay.
- Enhanced Precision D-Pad: Designed for quicker selection control and improved accuracy.
- Vibration Feedback: Built-in rumble feature provides immersive haptic feedback.

- Auto Powersave: Conserves energy by shutting down the controller after 5 minutes of inactivity.
- Advanced Li-Polymer Battery: Extends gaming duration.
- Future Proofed: Upgradable firmware via Gioteck software (requires a Windows operating system).

### 3. SETUP GUIDE

- 1. Charge the Controller: Before first use, fully charge the VX1 controller using a compatible USB charging cable (not always included, check packaging) connected to your PlayStation 3 console or a USB power adapter. The charging indicator light will typically show charging status.
- 2. **Insert the Wireless Dongle:** Locate the small USB wireless dongle included with your controller. Insert this dongle into an available USB port on your PlayStation 3 console.

#### 3. Pairing the Controller:

- Ensure the PS3 console is powered on.
- Press the central "PS" button on the VX1 controller.
- The controller should automatically connect to the dongle. The player indicator lights on the controller will illuminate to confirm successful pairing.
- If connection is lost or not established, try re-inserting the dongle and pressing the PS button again.

#### 4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

#### 4.1 Basic Controls

The VX1 controller features standard PlayStation button layouts, including:

- Directional Pad (D-Pad): For precise directional input.
- Action Buttons (Triangle, Circle, Cross, Square): For in-game actions.
- Analog Sticks: Dual analog sticks for movement and camera control.
- Shoulder Buttons (L1, L2, R1, R2): For various in-game functions, often triggers or secondary actions.
- PS Button: Central button for accessing the PS3 XMB menu and pairing.
- START/SELECT Buttons: For pausing games, accessing menus, etc.

#### 4.2 Powersave Mode

To conserve battery life, the VX1 controller features an automatic powersave mode. If the controller is inactive for approximately 5 minutes, it will automatically power down. To reactivate, simply press the central "PS" button.

#### 4.3 Firmware Updates

The VX1 controller's firmware can be updated to ensure optimal performance and compatibility. Firmware updates require a Windows operating system and Gioteck software. Please visit the official Gioteck website for the latest software and instructions.

### 5. MAINTENANCE

#### 5.1 Cleaning

To clean your controller, use a soft, dry cloth. For stubborn dirt, a slightly damp cloth with mild soap can be used, but ensure no liquid enters the controller's openings. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.

#### 5.2 Battery Care

The VX1 controller is powered by an advanced Li-Polymer battery. To maximize battery lifespan:

- · Avoid fully discharging the battery frequently.
- Store the controller in a cool, dry place when not in use for extended periods.
- Do not expose the controller to extreme temperatures.

### 5.3 Storage

When storing the controller, especially for long periods, ensure it is clean and charged to approximately 50%. Keep it away from direct sunlight, dust, and moisture.

#### 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Controller does not respond or connect.	Low battery, dongle not inserted, pairing issue, interference.	Charge the controller fully.  Ensure the USB dongle is securely inserted into the PS3.  Press the PS button to re-attempt pairing.  Try a different USB port on the PS3.  Reduce distance between controller and dongle.
Input lag or delayed response.	Wireless interference, distance from dongle, low battery.	Ensure controller is within optimal range of the dongle. Charge the controller. Minimize other 2.4GHz wireless devices nearby.
Controller randomly disconnects or pauses game.	Wireless interference, faulty dongle, low battery.	Re-pair the controller.  Try a different USB port for the dongle.  Ensure controller is charged.  Check for firmware updates.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Controller does not charge.	Faulty cable, faulty USB port, battery issue.	Try a different USB charging cable.  Try a different USB port on the PS3 or a different USB power source.  If the issue persists, contact Gioteck support.
