4. SETUP AND PREPARATION

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The OTO indicator solution is used to measure the free chlorine and bromine levels in your pool or spa water. Follow these general steps, but always prioritize the instructions from your specific test kit:

1. **Collect Water Sample:** Fill the designated test vial(s) from your pool or spa with water. For best results, collect the sample from elbow-depth, away from return jets.
2. **Add OTO Solution:** Add 5 drops of the Poolmaster OTO Indicator Solution to the test vial designated for chlorine/bromine testing.
3. **Mix:** Securely cap the vial and invert it several times to mix the solution with the water sample. Do not shake vigorously.
4. **Compare Color:** Immediately compare the color of the water sample in the vial to the color chart provided with your test kit. The color will indicate the chlorine or bromine level.
5. **Record Results:** Note down the readings. The ideal range for chlorine is typically 1-4 ppm, and for bromine, it is 2-6 ppm.

Note: For accurate pH test results, chlorine must be below 5.0 ppm or for Bromine below 11.0 ppm.

6. MAINTENANCE AND STORAGE

To ensure the longevity and accuracy of your OTO Indicator Solution, store the bottle in a cool, dry, and dark location. Replace the cap tightly after each use. It is recommended to replace reagents at the beginning of each pool season for optimal accuracy.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter unexpected readings or difficulty obtaining clear results:

- **Cloudy Sample:** Ensure the test vial is clean and free of debris. Collect a fresh water sample.
- **No Color Change:** Verify that the OTO solution has not expired. Ensure the correct number of drops were added.
- **Inconsistent Readings:** Re-test the water sample. Ensure proper mixing and comparison under natural daylight.
- **High Chlorine/Bromine:** If levels are too high, allow time for them to dissipate or follow your pool care professional's advice for reduction.
- **Low Chlorine/Bromine:** If levels are too low, add appropriate sanitizers as per your pool or spa manufacturer's guidelines.
