Introduction

Thank you for choosing the Atlanta 1668-19 Analog Alarm Clock. This manual provides detailed instructions for setting up, operating, and maintaining your new alarm clock. Product Overview

The Atlanta 1668-19 is a reliable analog alarm clock designed for ease of use. It features a clear dial, a quiet sweep second hand, and a light sensor for automatic illumination in low light conditions. Key components typically include:

- **Time Setting Knob:** Located on the back, used to adjust the current time.
- **Alarm Setting Knob:** Located on the back, used to set the desired alarm time.

Setup

1. Battery Installation:

- Insert one (1) AA battery (not included), ensuring the correct polarity (+ and -) as indicated inside the compartment.
- Close the battery compartment cover securely.

2. Setting the Current Time:

- Locate the *Time Setting Knob* on the back of the clock.
- Rotate the knob clockwise or counter-clockwise until the hour and minute hands display the correct current time.

3. Setting the Alarm Time:

- Locate the *Alarm Setting Knob* on the back of the clock.
- Rotate this knob until the alarm hand points to your desired alarm time.
- *Note:* The alarm hand moves independently of the time hands. Ensure you set it for AM or PM correctly if your clock has a 12-hour alarm cycle.

Operating Instructions

• Activating the Alarm:

- Slide the *Alarm ON/OFF Switch* to the 'ON' position. The alarm will sound at the set time.

• Snooze Function:

- When the alarm sounds, press the large *Snooze/Light Button* on top of the clock. The alarm will temporarily stop and sound again after approximately 5-10 minutes.

• Backlight Function:

- Press the *Snooze/Light Button* to briefly illuminate the clock face for easy viewing in the dark.
- The clock also features a *Light Sensor*. In low light conditions, the clock face may automatically illuminate dimly for continuous visibility.

• Stopping the Alarm:

- To permanently stop the alarm, slide the *Alarm ON/OFF Switch* to the 'OFF' position. The alarm will not sound again until reactivated.

Maintenance

• Cleaning:

- Wipe the clock with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or chemical solvents, as they may damage the casing or dial.
- Avoid exposing the clock to excessive dust or moisture.

• Battery Replacement:

- Replace the battery when the clock hands slow down, the alarm sound weakens, or the backlight becomes dim.
- Always use a fresh, high-quality AA battery.
- Remove exhausted batteries promptly to prevent leakage and damage to the clock.

Troubleshooting

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Clock not working / Hands not moving	Battery is dead or incorrectly inserted.	Check battery polarity or replace with a new AA battery.
Alarm does not sound	Alarm ON/OFF switch is in 'OFF' position; Alarm time not set correctly; Battery is low.	Slide switch to 'ON'; Re-set alarm time; Replace battery.
Backlight is dim or not working	Battery is low; Light sensor is covered.	Replace battery; Ensure light sensor (usually on the dial) is not obstructed.
Alarm sounds at wrong time	Alarm hand is set incorrectly.	Re-set the alarm time using the Alarm Setting Knob.
