1. INTRODUCTION

The BWT Best Max Premium M Water Filter Installation Kit with Filter Head is designed to optimize water quality for various applications, particularly for coffee machines and vending devices. This system ensures consistently high-quality, particle-free water, enhancing the taste of beverages and protecting your equipment from scale buildup.

The universal filter head is compatible with all BWT water filter cartridges and features an automatic shut-off valve for easy and safe filter changes. It can be installed both horizontally and vertically.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read all safety instructions carefully before installation and operation. Failure to follow these instructions may result in damage to the product, property, or personal injury.

- **Pressure:** Ensure the input pressure is within the specified range of 2 – 8 bar. Do not exceed maximum operating pressure.
- **Temperature:** The water temperature should be between 4 – 30 °C. The ambient temperature should be between 4 – 40 °C. Do not expose the unit to freezing temperatures.
- **Installation:** Installation should only be performed by qualified personnel in accordance with local plumbing codes and regulations.
- **Maintenance:** Always shut off the water supply and relieve pressure before performing any maintenance or filter changes.
- **Disposal:** Dispose of used filter cartridges according to local environmental regulations.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all components are present in the package:

- 1 x BWT Best Max Premium M Filter Cartridge (approx. 3800 litres capacity at 10 °dKH/blend 3)
- 1 x Universal Filter Head with backflow preventer and bypass adjustment
- 1 x Wall mounting bracket
- Connection fittings (e.g., AG3/8')

4. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Follow these steps for proper installation of your BWT water filter system:

1. **Choose Location:** Select a suitable location for installation, ensuring easy access for filter changes and maintenance. The filter head can be mounted horizontally or vertically.
2. **Mount Filter Head:** Use the provided wall mounting bracket to securely attach the universal filter head to a stable surface.
3. **Connect Water Supply:** Connect the water inlet to the filter head's inlet port (marked with an arrow indicating flow direction). Ensure all connections are tight to prevent leaks. The connection thread is 3/8 inch.
4. **Connect to Appliance:** Connect the filter head's outlet port to your coffee machine or vending device.
5. **Insert Filter Cartridge:** Align the BWT Best Max Premium M filter cartridge with the filter head and insert it by twisting until it locks securely into place. The automatic shut-off valve will engage.
6. **Adjust Bypass Setting:** The filter head features a bypass adjustment. Consult your appliance's requirements or local water hardness for the optimal blend setting. This setting determines the proportion of filtered water to bypass water.
7. **Flush System:** Slowly open the water supply. Flush the system with water for a few minutes (e.g., 1-2 liters) to remove any air and fine particles from the new filter. This initial flush is important for optimal performance.
8. **Check for Leaks:** Carefully inspect all connections for any signs of leaks.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once installed, the BWT Best Max Premium M filter system operates automatically. Water flows through the filter, undergoing optimization before reaching your appliance.

- **Continuous Filtration:** The system continuously filters water as it passes through, providing optimized water for your connected device.
- **Bypass Setting:** The bypass setting on the filter head allows you to fine-tune the water's mineral content to suit specific beverage requirements or local water conditions. Refer to the bypass adjustment guide for recommended settings based on water hardness.

6. MAINTENANCE

6.1. Filter Cartridge Replacement

The filter cartridge has a capacity of approximately 3800 litres (at 10 °dKH/blend 3) or should be replaced at least every 12 months, whichever comes first, to ensure optimal water quality and system performance.

1. **Shut Off Water:** Turn off the main water supply to the filter system.

2. **Relieve Pressure:** Briefly open a tap connected to the system to relieve any residual pressure.
3. **Remove Old Cartridge:** Twist the used filter cartridge counter-clockwise to unlock it from the filter head. The automatic shut-off valve will prevent water leakage.
4. **Insert New Cartridge:** Remove the protective cap from the new BWT Best Max Premium M filter cartridge. Align it with the filter head and insert it by twisting clockwise until it clicks securely into place.
5. **Flush New Cartridge:** Slowly open the water supply. Flush the new filter cartridge with water for a few minutes (e.g., 1-2 liters) to remove any air and fine particles.
6. **Check for Leaks:** Verify that there are no leaks around the new cartridge.
7. **Reset Reminder:** If your appliance has a filter change reminder, reset it according to its instructions.

6.2. Cleaning

The exterior of the filter head and cartridge can be wiped clean with a damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Water Leakage	Loose connections; improperly seated filter cartridge; damaged O-rings.	Tighten all connections. Ensure filter cartridge is fully twisted and locked. Inspect O-rings for damage and replace if necessary.
Reduced Water Flow	Clogged filter cartridge; low incoming water pressure; air in the system.	Replace filter cartridge if it has reached its capacity or is overdue for replacement. Check household water pressure. Flush the system to remove air.
Poor Water Taste/Quality	Expired filter cartridge; incorrect bypass setting.	Replace filter cartridge. Adjust bypass setting to optimize filtration for your water hardness.
