# Surker RFC-508 Cordless Ceramic Hair Clipper Instruction Manual

Model: RFC-508

## INTRODUCTION

Thank you for purchasing the Surker RFC-508 Cordless Ceramic Hair Clipper. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your device. Please read these instructions carefully before first use and retain them for future reference.

## IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

When using electrical appliances, basic safety precautions should always be followed, including the following:

- Read all instructions before using this appliance.
- Keep the appliance dry. Do not use it near water or in wet conditions.
- Do not immerse the appliance in water or any other liquid.
- Always unplug the appliance immediately after use and before cleaning.
- Do not reach for an appliance that has fallen into water. Unplug immediately.
- Close supervision is necessary when this appliance is used by, on, or near children or individuals with certain disabilities.
- Use this appliance only for its intended use as described in this manual.
- Never operate this appliance if it has a damaged cord or plug, if it is not working properly, or if it has been dropped or damaged.
- Keep the cord away from heated surfaces.
- Never drop or insert any object into any opening.
- Do not use outdoors or operate where aerosol (spray) products are being used or where oxygen is being administered.
- Always attach plug to appliance first, then to outlet. To disconnect, turn all controls to OFF, then remove plug from outlet.

- Do not use an extension cord with this appliance.
- Ensure the voltage specified on the charger matches your local power supply.

The Surker RFC-508 Cordless Ceramic Hair Clipper package typically includes:

- Main Hair Clipper Unit
- Charging Adapter
- Cleaning Brush
- Lubricating Oil
- Multiple Comb Attachments (various lengths)
- (Potentially) Additional Battery
- (Potentially) Detail Trimmer

*Note:* Actual contents may vary slightly based on the specific product package.

## SETUP

---

### 1. Initial Charging

1. Before first use, ensure the clipper is fully charged.
2. Connect the charging adapter to the clipper's charging port.
3. Plug the adapter into a suitable electrical outlet (100-240V AC, 50/60Hz).
4. The charging indicator light will illuminate (if present) to show charging is in progress.
5. Allow the clipper to charge for approximately 8-12 hours for the first charge. Subsequent charges may take less time.
6. Once fully charged, disconnect the adapter from the outlet and the clipper.

### 2. Attaching Comb Guides

- Select the desired comb attachment for your preferred hair length.
- Align the comb guide with the clipper blade and slide it firmly into place until it clicks.
- To remove, gently push the comb guide upwards and away from the blade.

### 3. Blade Adjustment

The clipper features an adjustable blade length dial (often located on the side or front of the clipper body). Rotate this dial to fine-tune the cutting length without a comb attachment, or to adjust the base length when a comb is attached.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

### 1. Before Clipping

- Ensure hair is clean, dry, and free of tangles.
- Comb hair in the direction of growth.
- Apply a small amount of lubricating oil to the blades before each use for optimal performance and longevity.

### 2. Turning On/Off

Locate the power switch (usually a slide switch) on the clipper body. Slide it to the "ON" position to start the clipper and to the "OFF" position to turn it off.

### 3. Hair Clipping Techniques

- Always start with a longer comb attachment than you think you need, and gradually reduce the length if desired.
- Hold the clipper with the blade teeth pointing upwards, flat against the head.
- Move the clipper slowly against the direction of hair growth.
- Overlap each stroke to ensure an even cut.
- For detailing or outlining, remove the comb attachment and use the bare blade, being careful around ears and neckline.

## MAINTENANCE

---

### 1. Cleaning After Each Use

1. Turn off the clipper and disconnect it from the power source.
2. Remove any comb attachments.
3. Use the provided cleaning brush to brush away loose hairs from the blades and the clipper body.
4. For thorough cleaning, the blade set can often be detached. Consult the specific instructions for blade removal if applicable to your model.
5. Do not rinse the clipper under water unless explicitly stated as waterproof.

### 2. Oiling the Blades

- After cleaning and before each use, apply 1-2 drops of the provided lubricating oil to the blades.
- Turn the clipper on for a few seconds to allow the oil to distribute evenly.
- Wipe off any excess oil with a soft cloth.
- Regular oiling ensures smooth operation, reduces friction, and prolongs blade life.

### 3. Storage

Store the clipper in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and moisture. Keep it out of reach of children.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Clipper does not turn on.	Battery is discharged.	Charge the clipper fully.
Clipper pulls hair or cuts poorly.	Blades are dull or dirty. Blades are not oiled.	Clean and oil the blades. If problem persists, blades may need replacement.
Clipper makes unusual noise.	Blades are not properly aligned or oiled.	Ensure blades are clean, oiled, and correctly seated.
Clipper gets hot during use.	Extended use or lack of lubrication.	Allow the clipper to cool down. Ensure blades are properly oiled. Avoid continuous long periods of operation.


