## INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the operation, maintenance, and care of your Armitron Sport Unisex Digital Chronograph Watch, Model 45-7004BLU. Please read this manual thoroughly to ensure proper use and longevity of your timepiece.

## KEY FEATURES

---

- Black resin case with blue top ring; case diameter 1.5 inches (40mm)
- LCD display with time, seconds, day and date
- Functions include: chronograph, lap time, alarm, dual time, military time and backlight
- Adjustable black nylon strap with hook-and-loop closure; fits from 5.5 inch to 7 inch wrist circumference
- Water resistant to 330 feet (100M)

## WATCH COMPONENTS

---

Your Armitron Sport watch features a durable resin case and a comfortable nylon strap. The digital display provides clear readability. Control buttons are located on the sides of the watch case for easy access to various functions.

## SETUP AND BASIC OPERATION

---

### Setting Time and Date

1. Press the **MODE** button repeatedly until the time setting mode is displayed (usually indicated by flashing digits).
2. Press the **RESET** button to select the digit or segment you wish to adjust (e.g., hours, minutes, year, month, day).
3. Use the **ST/STP** button to increase the selected value. Hold the button to rapidly advance the digits.
4. Repeat steps 2 and 3 until all desired time and date settings are correct.
5. Press the **MODE** button to exit the setting mode and return to normal time display.

### Using the Backlight (EL)

To illuminate the display in low-light conditions, press the **EL** button. The backlight will typically stay on for a few seconds.

## OPERATING MODES

---

Your watch features several operating modes accessible via the **MODE** button. Cycle through the modes by pressing **MODE** until the desired function appears.

- **Chronograph (Stopwatch):** Used for timing events. Press **ST/STP** to start/stop, and **RESET** to clear.
- **Lap Time:** A function within the chronograph mode to record intermediate times.
- **Alarm:** Set a specific time for an audible alert. Use **RESET** and **ST/STP** to set the alarm time.
- **Dual Time:** Allows you to display a second time zone.
- **Military Time (24-hour format):** The watch supports both 12-hour and 24-hour time formats. This setting can usually be toggled in the time setting mode.

## WATER RESISTANCE

This Armitron Sport watch is water resistant to 330 feet (100 meters). This rating indicates suitability for swimming and snorkeling, but it is not suitable for scuba diving. Avoid pressing buttons while the watch is submerged to prevent water ingress.

## MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the watch case and strap with a soft, damp cloth. For stubborn dirt, a mild soap solution can be used, followed by rinsing with clean water and drying thoroughly.
- **Battery Replacement:** When the display dims or functions become erratic, the battery may need replacement. It is recommended to have the battery replaced by a qualified watch technician to ensure the water resistance seal is maintained.
- **Storage:** Store your watch in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures when not in use.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

| Problem                     | Possible Cause / Solution  |
|-----------------------------|--|
| Display is blank or dim     | Low battery. Replace battery.  |
| Buttons are unresponsive    | Try pressing all buttons firmly. If issue persists, battery may be very low or internal fault. |
| Time is incorrect           | Refer to "Setting Time and Date" section to reset.   |
| Condensation inside display | Water ingress. Stop using immediately and seek professional repair to prevent further damage.  |
