## INTRODUCTION

It features a sturdy 1-3/8 inch high-grade steel frame with a thermoset baked-on, powder-coat finish for enhanced durability and corrosion resistance. The triple-layer, ripstop polyethylene cover is 100% waterproof and includes fade blockers to withstand various weather conditions. Key design elements such as the 6-rib frame, Easy Slide Cross Rail system, and Ratchet-Tite tensioning system contribute to its strength and ease of assembly.

## SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

---

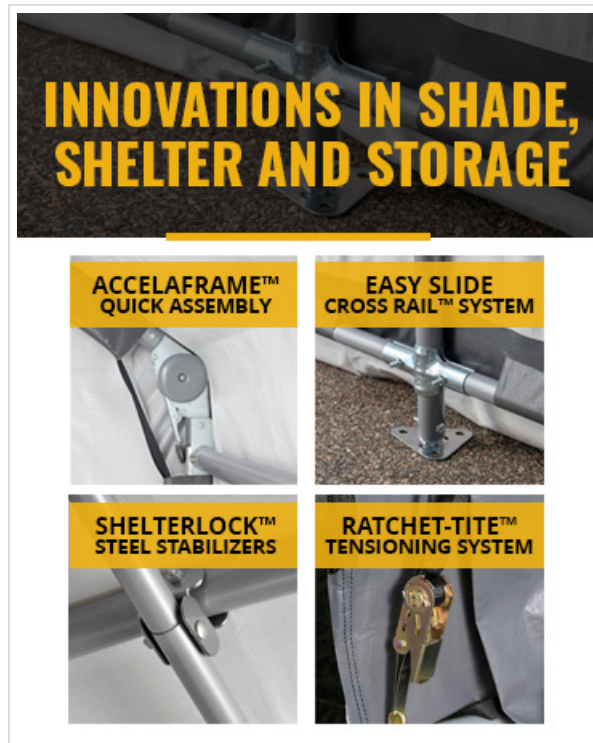
Assembly of the ShelterLogic Garage-in-a-Box Roundtop requires careful attention to detail and typically two people for efficient and safe installation. Refer to the complete assembly manual included with your product for detailed step-by-step instructions and diagrams.

### Key Assembly Features:

- **1-3/8 inch All-Steel Frame:** Constructed from high-grade steel, bonded with a thermoset premium powder-coated finish for durability and corrosion resistance.
- **Patented ShelterLock Stabilizers:** Designed to ensure rock-solid stability, contributing to a more durable shelter

structure.

- **Easy Slide Cross Rail System:** This system locks down the cover and allows for continuous cover tightening, ensuring a snug fit.
- **Ratchet-Tite Cover Tensioning System:** Utilizes quality ratchet and web strap components to ensure a drum-tight cover and secure door-panel connection to the shelter frame.

Ensure all frame components are correctly aligned and securely bolted at every roof joint connection. Once the frame is complete, carefully install the triple-layer ripstop polyethylene cover, utilizing the Easy Slide Cross Rail and Ratchet-Tite systems to achieve a tight, wrinkle-free fit. Finally, secure the shelter to the ground using the provided Auger anchors and steel foot plates as per the detailed instructions.

## OPERATION

---

The ShelterLogic Garage-in-a-Box Roundtop is designed for reliable outdoor storage. To ensure optimal performance and longevity:

- Always keep the door panels closed and secured when the shelter is not in use. This prevents wind from getting underneath the cover, which can cause damage or tearing.
- Ensure items stored inside do not press against the cover, as this can cause stress points and premature wear.
- Periodically check the cover tension and adjust the Ratchet-Tite system as needed to maintain a drum-tight fit.

## MAINTENANCE

---

Regular maintenance will extend the life of your ShelterLogic Garage-in-a-Box Roundtop.

- **Cover Care:** The triple-layer, ripstop polyethylene cover is waterproof and features fade blockers. Clean the cover periodically with mild soap and water. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- **Frame Inspection:** Regularly check the steel frame for any signs of rust, corrosion, or damage. The thermoset powder-

coated finish is designed to resist chipping, peeling, and rust, but environmental factors can still cause wear.

- **Anchoring System:** Inspect the Auger anchors and steel foot plates regularly to ensure they remain securely fastened to the ground. Re-tighten if necessary.
- **Snow Removal:** In areas with heavy snowfall, it is recommended to remove accumulated snow from the cover to prevent excessive weight and potential structural damage. Use a soft brush or broom to avoid damaging the cover.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure adequate airflow to minimize condensation inside the shelter, especially during humid conditions.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

Issue	Possible Cause	Solution
Condensation inside shelter	Lack of ventilation, humidity differences.	Ensure adequate airflow by opening door panels when conditions allow. Consider adding ventilation options if available.
Cover appears loose or wrinkled	Insufficient tensioning, shifting frame.	Re-tension the cover using the Ratchet-Tite system. Verify frame stability and anchoring.
Small holes or tears in cover	Wear and tear, sharp objects, environmental damage.	Patch small holes with a suitable repair kit. For larger damage, consider a replacement cover.
Frame components do not align	Manufacturing variation, incorrect assembly step.	Carefully review the assembly manual. Ensure all parts are oriented correctly. Some minor adjustments may be needed.
Ratchet straps bending/failing	Excessive force, material fatigue.	Avoid over-tightening. If straps are damaged, replace them with high-quality alternatives.
