## IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

---

Please read this instruction manual carefully before assembly and use. Keep these instructions for future reference. This product is designed for children aged 36 months to 8 years. Adult supervision is required at all times during use.

- **Choking Hazard:** Small parts may be present during assembly. Keep away from young children.
- **Fall Hazard:** Ensure the trailer is securely attached to a compatible pedal tractor before use. Do not overload the trailer.
- **Operating Environment:** Use on flat, stable surfaces. Avoid slopes, stairs, and uneven terrain.
- **Protective Gear:** Always ensure the child wears appropriate protective gear, such as a helmet, when operating a pedal tractor with the trailer.
- **Maintenance:** Regularly inspect the product for damage or wear. Do not use if damaged.

## PRODUCT OVERVIEW

---

The RollyStreumax John Deere 125111 is a single-axle spreader trailer designed for use with Rolly Toys pedal tractors. It features a green and yellow John Deere design, a protected drive chain, and a functional spreading mechanism. This trailer is not compatible with RollyMinitrac and RollyKid models.

## Key Features:

- Functional chain mechanism that operates with the wheels to spread material.
- Spreading speed controlled by the connected tow pedals of the tractor.
- Removable lid for easy filling.
- Compatible with all large Rolly Toys pedal tractors.
- Spreading function can be deactivated using a handle on the front.

## PACKAGE CONTENTS

---

The RollyStreumax John Deere 125111 Spreader Trailer package typically includes the following components:

- Main trailer body (1 piece)
- Axle and wheels (1 set)
- Lid (1 piece)
- Assembly hardware (screws, caps, etc.)
- Instruction manual (this document)

Please verify all parts are present before beginning assembly. If any parts are missing or damaged, contact customer support.

## ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

---

This product requires adult assembly. Follow these steps carefully:

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully remove all parts from the packaging and lay them out on a clean, flat surface.
2. **Attach Wheels to Axle:** Insert the axle through the designated slots on the trailer body. Secure the wheels onto the axle ends using the provided caps or fasteners. Ensure they are firmly attached but can rotate freely.
3. **Secure Undercarriage:** Attach any undercarriage components or protective covers as indicated in the diagrams.
4. **Install Lid:** Place the removable lid onto the top of the trailer body.
5. **Final Check:** Before use, ensure all connections are secure and all parts are correctly assembled.

## SETUP

---

To prepare the RollyStreumax trailer for use:

1. **Attach to Pedal Tractor:** Connect the trailer's hitch to the designated attachment point on a compatible Rolly Toys pedal tractor. Ensure the connection is secure and cannot accidentally detach during play.
2. **Fill with Material:** Open the removable lid and fill the trailer with suitable spreading material, such as sand, small pebbles, or play dirt. Do not overfill.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

The RollyStreamax trailer is designed for interactive play, simulating a real spreader:

1. **Engage Spreading Mechanism:** If the spreading function is deactivated, locate the handle on the front of the trailer and move it to the 'ON' position to engage the spreading mechanism.
2. **Begin Movement:** As the pedal tractor moves forward, the trailer's wheels will turn. This rotation drives the internal chain mechanism, which in turn activates the spreader.
3. **Control Spreading Speed:** The rate at which material is spread is directly related to the speed of the pedal tractor. Faster movement results in a wider and more continuous spread.
4. **Deactivate Spreading:** To stop spreading material, move the handle on the front of the trailer to the 'OFF' position. This disengages the spreading mechanism, allowing the trailer to be used for transport without dispensing its contents.

## MAINTENANCE

---

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and safe operation of your RollyStreumax trailer:

- **Cleaning:** Clean the trailer regularly with a damp cloth. For stubborn dirt, use mild soap and water. Rinse thoroughly and dry completely. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Inspection:** Periodically check all parts for wear, damage, or loose connections. Pay close attention to the wheels, axle, chain mechanism, and hitch.
- **Lubrication:** The drive chain is protected and generally does not require lubrication. If any moving parts become stiff, a small amount of silicone-based lubricant can be applied, avoiding contact with plastic surfaces that could degrade.
- **Storage:** Store the trailer in a clean, dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures, to prevent material degradation.
- **Repairs:** Do not attempt to repair damaged parts with non-original components. Contact Rolly Toys customer service for genuine spare parts.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

---

If you encounter issues with your RollyStreumax trailer, consider the following:

- **Spreading Mechanism Not Working:**
  - Ensure the spreading handle on the front is in the 'ON' position.
  - Check if the trailer wheels are turning when the tractor moves.
  - Inspect the chain mechanism for any obstructions or damage.
  - Verify that the material inside is not too wet or clumpy, which could jam the mechanism.
- **Trailer Detaches from Tractor:**
  - Ensure the hitch connection is fully engaged and secured.
  - Check for wear or damage on both the trailer hitch and the tractor's attachment point.
- **Wheels Not Turning Freely:**
  - Inspect the axle and wheels for any debris, dirt, or hair that might be causing friction.
  - Check if the wheel caps are too tight, impeding rotation.
