SETUP AND INSTALLATION

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Using your MSA Soprano Earmuffs correctly ensures maximum hearing protection.

Usage:

1. **Donning:** With the earmuffs attached to your safety hat, place the hat on your head. Pivot the earmuff cups downwards so they fully cover your ears.
2. **Adjust for Seal:** Gently press the earcups against your head to ensure a complete and comfortable seal around your ears. There should be no gaps between the earmuff cushions and your skin.

3. **Removal:** To remove, pivot the earmuff cups upwards and away from your ears, then remove the safety hat.

Important: For optimal protection, avoid wearing anything that interferes with the earmuff seal, such as thick glasses frames, long hair, or other headwear that might create gaps.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Cleaning:

- Clean the earmuffs regularly with mild soap and water.
- Wipe surfaces with a soft cloth. Do not immerse the earmuffs in water.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Earmuffs do not provide adequate noise reduction.	Poor seal around the ears; damaged ear cushions; incorrect fit.	Ensure earmuffs are fully covering ears and creating a tight seal. Adjust position. Inspect ear cushions for wear and replace if damaged. Ensure no obstructions (e.g., thick hair, glasses arms) are breaking the seal.
Earmuffs feel uncomfortable or too tight.	Improper adjustment; new earmuffs.	Adjust the position on the hat to find a comfortable fit. New earmuffs may feel slightly tight initially but should conform over time. If discomfort persists, consult the manufacturer.
Earmuffs do not stay securely attached to the hat.	Incorrect installation; damaged attachment points on earmuffs or hat.	Re-install earmuffs, ensuring they click firmly into place. Inspect attachment arms and hat slots for damage. If damaged, replace the affected component or the entire unit.


