Orbegozo KFN 310 Italian Coffee Maker User Manual

Model: KFN 310 | Capacity: 3 Cups

1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Orbegozo KFN 310 Italian Coffee Maker. This manual provides essential instructions for the safe and efficient use of your new coffee maker. The KFN 310 is an aluminum stovetop espresso maker designed to brew rich, aromatic coffee. It features a 3-cup capacity, an ergonomic handle for comfortable pouring, a safety valve for pressure regulation, and a removable filter for easy cleaning. It is compatible with gas, electric, and ceramic hobs.

2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Read all instructions before using the appliance.
- Do not touch hot surfaces. Use handles or knobs.
- To protect against fire, electric shock, and injury to persons, do not immerse cord, plugs, or appliance in water or other liquid.
- Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children.

- Unplug from outlet when not in use and before cleaning. Allow to cool before putting on or taking off parts, and before cleaning the appliance.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug or after the appliance malfunctions, or has been damaged in any manner.
- The use of accessory attachments not recommended by the appliance manufacturer may result in fire, electric shock, or injury to persons.
- Do not use outdoors.
- Do not let cord hang over edge of table or counter, or touch hot surfaces.
- Do not place on or near a hot gas or electric burner, or in a heated oven.
- Always attach plug to appliance first, then plug cord into the wall outlet. To disconnect, turn any control to “off,” then remove plug from wall outlet.
- Do not use appliance for other than intended use.
- Ensure the safety valve is never obstructed.
- Do not overfill the water chamber above the safety valve level.
- Always ensure the upper and lower chambers are securely screwed together before placing on a heat source.

3. PARTS DIAGRAM

Familiarize yourself with the components of your Orbegozo KFN 310 Italian Coffee Maker for proper assembly and use.

1. Upper Chamber (Collector)
2. Gasket
3. Filter Plate
4. Filter Funnel (Basket)
5. Lower Chamber (Water Boiler) with Safety Valve

4. INITIAL SETUP

Before using your coffee maker for the first time, follow these steps:

1. **Unpack:** Carefully remove all packaging materials and dispose of them responsibly.
2. **Wash Components:** Disassemble the coffee maker completely. Wash all parts (upper chamber, filter plate, gasket, filter funnel, lower chamber) with warm water and a mild detergent. Rinse thoroughly to remove any residue.
3. **First Brews (Seasoning):** To season the coffee maker and remove any metallic taste, brew coffee 2-3 times using only water and a small amount of inexpensive ground coffee. Discard these initial brews. This process

helps to create a protective layer inside the aluminum, enhancing the flavor of future coffee.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps to brew delicious coffee with your Orbegozo KFN 310:

1. **Fill Lower Chamber:** Unscrew the upper chamber from the lower chamber. Fill the lower chamber with cold water up to the level of the safety valve. Do not exceed this level.

2. **Insert Filter Funnel:** Place the filter funnel into the lower chamber.
3. **Add Ground Coffee:** Fill the filter funnel with medium-fine ground coffee. Do not tamp the coffee down. Level the grounds gently without pressing.

4. **Assemble:** Ensure the gasket and filter plate are correctly positioned in the upper chamber. Screw the upper chamber tightly onto the lower chamber. Use the handle for leverage, but avoid overtightening.
5. **Place on Heat Source:** Place the coffee maker on a stovetop burner (gas, electric, or ceramic). Use a medium heat setting. For gas hobs, ensure the flame does not extend beyond the base of the coffee maker.
6. **Brew:** Water in the lower chamber will heat up, creating steam pressure that forces water through the coffee

grounds and up into the upper chamber. You will hear a gurgling sound as the coffee brews.

7. **Serve:** Once the upper chamber is full of coffee and the gurgling sound subsides, remove the coffee maker from the heat. Serve immediately.

6. MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Proper cleaning and maintenance will extend the life of your coffee maker and ensure consistent coffee quality.

- **Cool Down:** Always allow the coffee maker to cool completely before disassembling and cleaning.
- **Disassemble:** Unscrew the upper chamber from the lower chamber. Remove the filter plate, gasket, and filter funnel.
- **Discard Grounds:** Dispose of used coffee grounds. Do not tap the filter funnel against hard surfaces to remove grounds, as this can damage it.
- **Wash:** Wash all parts with warm water and a mild, non-abrasive detergent. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive scrubbers, which can damage the aluminum finish.
- **Rinse Thoroughly:** Rinse all components thoroughly to remove any soap residue.
- **Dry Completely:** Dry all parts completely before reassembling or storing to prevent water spots and corrosion. Do not store assembled if wet.
- **Regular Inspection:** Periodically check the gasket and filter plate for wear and tear. Replace them if they appear cracked, brittle, or damaged to maintain a proper seal and optimal brewing performance.
- **Not Dishwasher Safe:** This coffee maker is not dishwasher safe. Hand washing is recommended.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Refer to this table for common issues and their solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Coffee does not brew or brews slowly.	Insufficient water, coffee too finely ground, coffee tamped too tightly, heat too low, clogged filter.	Ensure water is filled to the safety valve. Use medium-fine grind. Do not tamp coffee. Increase heat. Clean filter and funnel.
Coffee leaks from the middle joint.	Upper and lower chambers not screwed tightly, worn or improperly seated gasket, damaged rim.	Ensure chambers are tightly screwed. Check gasket for proper seating and wear; replace if necessary. Inspect rims for damage.
Coffee tastes weak or watery.	Too much water, too coarse grind, not enough coffee, brewing too fast.	Fill water to safety valve. Use medium-fine grind. Ensure filter funnel is full. Reduce heat slightly.
Coffee tastes burnt or bitter.	Heat too high, coffee brewed for too long, coffee too finely ground.	Reduce heat. Remove from heat as soon as brewing is complete. Use a slightly coarser grind.
Safety valve hisses or releases steam.	Overfilled water chamber, clogged filter, coffee tamped too tightly.	Do not fill water above the safety valve. Clean filter and funnel. Do not tamp coffee.
