SETUP

Follow these steps to set up your Ttec TK6105 Desktop Phone:

1. **Connect the Handset:** Plug one end of the coiled handset cord into the jack on the side of the phone unit marked with a handset icon. Plug the other end into the jack on the bottom of the handset.
2. **Connect the Telephone Line:** Plug one end of the telephone line cord into the jack on the back of the phone unit marked with a wall jack icon. Plug the other end into your telephone wall outlet.
3. **Placement:** Place the phone on a flat, stable surface, away from direct sunlight, heat sources, and excessive moisture. Ensure proper ventilation.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

This section details the basic operations of your Ttec TK6105 Desktop Phone.

Making a Call

1. Lift the handset.
2. Listen for a dial tone.
3. Dial the desired phone number using the keypad.
4. Wait for the call to connect.

Receiving a Call

- When the phone rings, lift the handset to answer the call.
- To end the call, place the handset back into the cradle.

Volume Control

Adjust the handset volume during a call using the dedicated volume buttons (if present) or the general volume controls on the phone unit.

Redial Function

To redial the last number called, lift the handset and press the **REDIAL** button.

Mute Function

During a call, press the **MUTE** button to temporarily disable your microphone. The other party will not hear you. Press **MUTE** again to resume conversation.

MAINTENANCE

Proper care and maintenance will ensure the longevity of your Ttec TK6105 Desktop Phone.

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the phone's surface. For stubborn dirt, slightly dampen the cloth with water. Do not use abrasive cleaners, waxes, or solvents.
- **Avoid Liquids:** Keep the phone away from water and other liquids. If liquid spills on the phone, immediately unplug it and allow it to dry completely before reconnecting.
- **Storage:** If storing the phone for an extended period, disconnect it from the telephone line and store it in a cool, dry place.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your phone, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No dial tone	Telephone line cord is loose or disconnected.	Ensure the telephone line cord is securely plugged into both the phone and the wall outlet.
Cannot make or receive calls	Line issue from service provider; phone malfunction.	Test with another phone if available. Contact your telephone service provider.
Poor sound quality	Loose connections; interference.	Check all connections. Move the phone away from other electronic devices.




