## 1. INTRODUCTION

---

Thank you for purchasing the Merkurs Innovations Bluetooth Keyboard, model M-BTWK10. This ultra-slim, wireless, and portable keyboard is designed to enhance your typing experience with compatible devices such as iPads, iPhones, iPods, and other smartphones and tablets. Its full-sized keys, including numeric and special function keys, provide a comfortable and efficient typing solution.

## 2. KEY FEATURES

### 4. SETUP AND PAIRING

#### 4.1. Installing Batteries

The Mercury Innovations Bluetooth Keyboard is powered by batteries. Locate the battery compartment on the underside of the keyboard. Insert the required number of batteries (typically 1 x AAA battery, though specific type may vary) ensuring correct polarity (+/-) as indicated inside the compartment. Close the battery cover securely.

#### 4.2. Powering On the Keyboard

Slide the ON/OFF switch, located on the keyboard, to the 'ON' position. The battery indicator light will briefly illuminate, indicating the keyboard is powered on.

#### 4.3. Bluetooth Pairing

To connect your keyboard to a device, follow these steps:

1. Ensure the keyboard is powered on.
2. On your device (iPad, iPhone, iPod, tablet, or smartphone), go to **Settings**.
3. Navigate to the **Bluetooth** settings.
4. Turn Bluetooth 'ON' if it is not already enabled.
5. Your device will begin searching for nearby Bluetooth devices.
6. Look for "Mercury Innovations Keyboard" or a similar name in the list of available devices.
7. Tap on the keyboard's name to initiate the pairing process.
8. If prompted, enter the pairing code displayed on your device's screen using the Mercury Innovations keyboard, then press **Enter**.
9. Once successfully paired, the device will show the keyboard as "Connected" or "Paired".

The keyboard is now ready for use with your device.

## 5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

### 5.1. Basic Typing

Once connected, the keyboard functions like a standard QWERTY keyboard. Simply open any application that requires text input (e.g., Notes, Mail, Safari) and begin typing.

### 5.2. Using Function Keys

The Mercury Innovations Bluetooth Keyboard includes special function keys (F1-F12) that provide quick access to various features on compatible devices. These often include media controls, volume adjustments, and other system functions. The specific functionality of these keys may vary depending on your device's operating system (iOS, Android, Mac OS).

Common function key actions may include:

### 5.3. Powering Off the Keyboard

To conserve battery life, slide the ON/OFF switch to the 'OFF' position when the keyboard is not in use for an extended period.

## 6. MAINTENANCE

---

### 6.1. Cleaning

To clean the keyboard, gently wipe the surface with a soft, lint-free cloth. For stubborn dirt, slightly dampen the cloth with water or a mild, non-abrasive cleaning solution. Avoid excessive moisture and do not spray cleaners directly onto the keyboard.

### 6.2. Battery Replacement

When the battery indicator light remains off or the keyboard fails to connect/function properly, it may be time to replace the batteries. Follow the instructions in Section 4.1 to replace the batteries. Dispose of old batteries responsibly according to local regulations.

## 7. TROUBLESHOOTING

---

### 7.1. Keyboard Not Connecting/Pairing

- Ensure the keyboard is powered on and has fresh batteries.
- Make sure Bluetooth is enabled on your device.
- Ensure the keyboard is within the effective Bluetooth range (typically 10 meters or 33 feet) of your device.
- Try turning the keyboard off and on again.
- On your device, try forgetting the keyboard from the Bluetooth device list and then re-pairing it.
- Restart your device and try the pairing process again.

### 7.2. Keys Not Responding

- Check battery level and replace batteries if necessary.
- Ensure the keyboard is properly connected to your device. If not, re-pair it.
- Test the keyboard with another compatible device to rule out a device-specific issue.

### 7.3. Lag or Delayed Input

- Ensure there are no obstructions between the keyboard and your device.
- Reduce the distance between the keyboard and your device.
- Minimize other active Bluetooth devices in the vicinity that might cause interference.
