## **INTRODUCTION**

The Solo Stove Lite is a highly efficient, portable wood-burning stove designed for outdoor enthusiasts. Its unique double-wall construction promotes ultra-clean gasification and secondary combustion, resulting in a hotter burn with minimal smoke. This manual provides comprehensive instructions to ensure safe and optimal use of your Solo Stove Lite.

## SETUP

---

Proper setup is crucial for safe and efficient operation of your Solo Stove Lite.

- 1. Gather Fuel:** Collect dry twigs, small branches (2-3 inches in length), and tinder. Hardwoods are recommended for best performance and less smoke.
- 2. Find Level Ground:** Select a stable, flat surface for the stove.
- 3. Clear Area:** Ensure a 5-foot radius around the stove is clear of any flammable debris, dry leaves, or grass.
- 4. Assemble Stove:** The Solo Stove Lite consists of two main parts: the main stove body and the cooking ring. Place the cooking ring on top of the stove body.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

Follow these steps to operate your Solo Stove Lite for cooking or boiling water.

1. **Load Fuel:** Place a small amount of tinder and kindling inside the stove.
2. **Light Fire:** Ignite the tinder. Once the fire is established, gradually add more small pieces of wood through the top opening.
3. **Maintain Flame:** The unique double-wall design and vent holes (360° Airflow Design) will draw in air from the bottom, feeding the primary combustion, and then preheated air will rise through the inner wall to fuel the secondary combustion, leading to a more efficient and low-smoke burn. Continue to feed small pieces of wood as needed to maintain the desired flame.
4. **Cooking:** Place your pot or pan on the cooking ring. The stove is designed to boil water in 8-10 minutes (34 fl oz).


## 1. Gather Dry Twigs & Tinder




## 2. Find Level Ground

## MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and performance of your Solo Stove Lite, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** After each use, allow the stove to cool completely. Empty any remaining ash from the bottom. A stiff brush can be used to remove stubborn residue.
- **Storage:** Store the stove in its included nylon stuff sack in a dry place to prevent corrosion.
- **Material Care:** The stove is made of premium stainless steel. While durable, avoid abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals that could damage the finish.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

Here are some common issues and their solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Excessive Smoke	Wet or green wood; insufficient airflow.	Use only dry, seasoned wood. Ensure vent holes are clear and not obstructed. Add smaller pieces of fuel to increase heat and promote secondary combustion.
Difficulty Lighting	Insufficient tinder or kindling; damp fuel.	Use plenty of dry tinder (e.g., cotton balls, paper, fine wood shavings) and small, dry kindling. Ensure proper air circulation.
Flame Dies Quickly	Lack of fuel; poor fuel quality; ash buildup.	Continuously feed small amounts of dry fuel. Empty ash regularly to maintain airflow.





Image: Visual representation of the Solo Stove Lite's compact dimensions and lightweight design.
