TAG Heuer Monza Limited Edition Men's Watch CR5112.FC6290 User Manual

INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the proper use, care, and maintenance of your TAG Heuer Monza Limited Edition Men's Watch, model CR5112.FC6290. This timepiece features an automatic movement and chronograph functions, embodying precision Swiss engineering. Please read these instructions carefully to ensure optimal performance and longevity of your watch.

SETUP

Initial Winding and Time Setting

- Unscrew the Crown:** If your watch has a screw-down crown, gently unscrew it counter-clockwise until it springs out to position 1.
- Manual Winding:** In position 1, turn the crown clockwise approximately 30-40 times. This will provide sufficient power reserve to start the automatic movement.
- Setting the Time:** Pull the crown out to position 2. Turn the crown clockwise or counter-clockwise to set the hour and minute hands to the correct time.
- Setting the Date (if applicable):** For models with a date function, pull the crown out to position 1 (after winding). Turn the crown to adjust the date. Avoid setting the date between 9 PM and 3 AM, as this can damage the movement.
- Secure the Crown:** Once the time and date are set, push the crown back into position 0. If it is a screw-down crown, gently push and screw it clockwise until it is fully secured against the case to maintain water resistance.

Adjusting the Deployment Clasp

Your watch is equipped with a deployment clasp for secure and comfortable wear. To adjust the strap length, locate the spring bars or pins on the clasp mechanism. Use a small tool to release the spring bar and slide the strap to the desired position. Ensure the spring bar is securely re-engaged in the appropriate hole for a snug fit.

OPERATING THE WATCH

Automatic Movement

The TAG Heuer Monza CR5112.FC6290 is powered by an automatic mechanical movement. This means the watch is wound by the natural motion of your wrist. When worn regularly, the oscillating weight inside the watch rotates, winding the mainspring and maintaining the power reserve. If the watch is not worn for an extended period, it will stop. Refer to the 'Initial Winding' section to restart it.

Chronograph Function

Your watch features a chronograph, allowing you to measure elapsed time. It typically operates with two push-buttons located on either side of the crown.

1. **Start:** Press the top push-button to start the chronograph seconds hand.
2. **Stop:** Press the top push-button again to stop the chronograph. The elapsed time can be read from the chronograph subdials and the central seconds hand.

3. **Reset:** Press the bottom push-button to reset all chronograph hands to zero. This button should only be pressed when the chronograph is stopped.

Water Resistance

This watch has a water resistance rating of 50 meters (5 ATM). This means it is suitable for short periods of recreational swimming. It is not suitable for diving, snorkeling, or high-impact water sports. Always ensure the crown is fully pushed in and, if applicable, screwed down, before any contact with water. Avoid operating the push-buttons or crown while the watch is wet or submerged.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning

To clean your watch, use a soft, damp cloth. For the case and metal bracelet (if applicable), a mild soap solution can be used, followed by rinsing with clean water and drying thoroughly. For leather straps, avoid excessive moisture and harsh chemicals. Clean gently with a dry or slightly damp cloth. Allow the strap to air dry completely.

Service Intervals

Mechanical watches, including automatic movements, require periodic servicing to maintain accuracy and ensure longevity. It is recommended to have your TAG Heuer watch serviced by an authorized service center every 3-5 years. This service typically includes cleaning, lubrication, and adjustment of the movement, as well as replacement of seals to maintain water resistance.

Storage

When not wearing your watch, store it in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight, extreme temperatures, and strong magnetic fields. The original watch box is ideal for storage. If storing for an extended period, ensure the watch is fully wound before storage, or consider a watch winder to keep the automatic movement running.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Watch Has Stopped:** If the watch has stopped, it likely needs to be wound. Manually wind the watch using the crown (refer to 'Initial Winding' section). If it still does not start, the power reserve may be depleted, or it may require servicing.
- **Time Inaccuracy:** Slight variations in timekeeping are normal for mechanical watches. However, if your watch is consistently gaining or losing significant time, it may need adjustment or servicing. Exposure to strong magnetic fields can also affect accuracy.
- **Condensation Under Crystal:** If you notice condensation under the sapphire crystal, this indicates a breach in water resistance. Immediately take the watch to an authorized service center to prevent further damage to the movement.
- **Chronograph Not Resetting to Zero:** If the chronograph hands do not reset precisely to zero, it may require adjustment. This is a common issue that can be corrected by an authorized technician.
