## **Setup**

Your Powermag+ magnifier requires 3 AAA batteries for the LED illumination. These batteries are typically included with your purchase.

- 1. Locate the battery compartment cover on the handle of the magnifier.
- 2. Gently slide or unclip the cover to open the compartment.
- 3. Insert 3 AAA batteries, ensuring the correct positive (+) and negative (-) polarity as indicated inside the compartment.
- 4. Replace the battery compartment cover, ensuring it is securely closed.

# **Operating Instructions**

- 1. **Turning On/Off the LED Light:** Locate the power switch or button on the handle of the magnifier. Press or slide it to turn the LED light on. Press or slide it again to turn the light off.
- 2. **Using the Magnifier:** Hold the magnifier above the object or text you wish to magnify. Adjust the distance between the magnifier and the object until the image appears clear and in focus. The integrated LED light will illuminate the viewing area for enhanced clarity.
- 3. Optimal Viewing: For best results, hold the magnifier parallel to the surface of the object being viewed.

## **Maintenance**

- Cleaning the Lens: Use a soft, lint-free cloth (e.g., a microfiber cloth) specifically designed for optical lenses. Gently wipe the lens surface to remove dust or smudges. Do not use abrasive cleaners, paper towels, or harsh chemicals, as these can scratch the lens.
- Cleaning the Body: Wipe the body of the magnifier with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid getting moisture into the battery compartment or LED light area.
- Battery Replacement: When the LED light dims or stops working, it's time to replace the batteries. Follow the battery installation steps outlined in the "Setup" section. Dispose of used batteries according to local regulations.
- Storage: Store the magnifier in a clean, dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

# **Troubleshooting**

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
LED light does not turn on.	Dead or incorrectly installed batteries.	Check battery polarity. Replace with new AAA batteries.
Magnified image is blurry.	Incorrect distance from object; dirty lens.	Adjust the distance between the magnifier and the object. Clean the lens as described in the Maintenance section.
Light is dim.	Low battery power.	Replace batteries with new AAA batteries.
