NTRODUCTION

SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps to prepare and install a new BWT Magnesium Gourmet water filter cartridge:

- 1. **Unpack the Cartridge:** Remove the new filter cartridge from its protective packaging.
- 2. **Initial Soaking (Priming):** Submerge the new cartridge completely in cold tap water for approximately 5-10 minutes. This helps to remove any air bubbles and prepares the filter material.

- 3. **Insert into Pitcher:** Place the primed cartridge firmly into the funnel of your compatible BWT water filter pitcher. Ensure it is seated correctly to prevent unfiltered water from bypassing the filter.
- 4. **First Fill:** Fill the pitcher with cold tap water. Allow the water to filter through the cartridge. Discard the first two filtered fillings. This flushes out any loose filter particles.
- 5. Ready for Use: Your BWT water filter is now ready for use.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

To use your BWT water filter pitcher with the installed cartridge:

- Fill with Cold Water: Always fill the pitcher with cold tap water. Do not use hot water, as it can damage the filter material.
- **Allow Filtration:** Let the water slowly pass through the filter cartridge into the main reservoir of the pitcher. The filtration process is designed to be efficient, providing quick access to filtered water.
- **Storage:** Store the filtered water in a cool, dark place, preferably in the refrigerator, to maintain freshness. Consume filtered water within 24 hours.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the continued effectiveness of your BWT water filter system.

Cartridge Replacement

- **Frequency:** Replace the filter cartridge approximately every 4 weeks or after filtering 120 liters (approximately 31.7 gallons) of water, whichever comes first. For a pack of 4 cartridges, this provides up to 4 months of filtration.
- Indicator: Many BWT pitchers include an electronic or manual indicator to remind you when to change the cartridge. Refer to your pitcher's specific manual for details on its indicator.
- Disposal: Dispose of used cartridges according to local recycling guidelines.

Cleaning the Pitcher

Regularly clean your water filter pitcher with mild detergent and warm water. Ensure all parts are thoroughly rinsed before reassembling. The pitcher (excluding the lid with electronics, if applicable) may be dishwasher safe; consult your pitcher's manual for specific cleaning instructions.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your BWT water filter cartridges, consider the following:

Slow Filtration:

- Ensure the cartridge was properly primed (soaked in water) before installation.
- · Check if the cartridge is correctly seated in the funnel.
- If the cartridge is old, it may be saturated. Replace it with a new one.

· Unusual Taste or Odor:

- Ensure the first two filtered fillings were discarded after installing a new cartridge.
- Verify that the cartridge is not past its recommended usage period. Replace if necessary.
- Store filtered water in a cool place and consume within 24 hours.

• Water Leaking Around Cartridge:

• Remove and re-insert the cartridge, ensuring it is securely fitted into the funnel.
