

4. MAINTENANCE

Proper care of your game cartridge and console will ensure long-lasting enjoyment:

- **Storage:** Store game cartridges in their original cases or a protective container away from direct sunlight, extreme temperatures, and excessive dust.
- Cleaning: If a cartridge is not working correctly, gently clean the gold connector pins on the bottom of the cartridge with a cotton swab lightly dampened with isopropyl alcohol. Allow to dry completely before reinserting.
- **Handling:** Avoid touching the connector pins with your fingers, as oils and dirt can interfere with connectivity.
- Console Care: Keep your Atari 2600 console clean and free of dust. Refer to the console's manual for specific cleaning instructions.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues while playing Vanguard, try these common troubleshooting steps:

• Blank Screen/No Game:

- Ensure the cartridge is fully inserted into the console.
- Turn the console off, remove the cartridge, reinsert it firmly, and turn the console back on.
- Check all video and power connections between the console and the television.
- Clean the cartridge connector pins as described in the Maintenance section.

• Flickering Graphics/Sound Issues:

- This can often be resolved by reseating the cartridge.
- Ensure your television is set to the correct input channel (e.g., Channel 2 or 3).

• Controller Unresponsive:

- Ensure the joystick is securely plugged into the correct port.


