2. SETUP & INSTALLATION

The R0524900 Engine Assembly is designed for straightforward replacement in compatible Zodiac pool cleaners. While the assembly itself requires no prior assembly, installation into your cleaner involves a few simple steps.

1. **Prepare the Cleaner:** Ensure your pool cleaner is disconnected from the pool system and removed from the water.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

If your Zodiac MX6 or MX8 pool cleaner is not performing as expected after replacing the engine assembly, consider the following troubleshooting steps:

Common Issues & Solutions:

- **Cleaner Not Moving or Moving Slowly:**
 - Ensure the new engine assembly is correctly seated and all connections are secure.
 - Check for blockages in the cleaner's intake or hoses.
 - Verify that your pool pump is operating at the correct pressure and flow rate.
 - Inspect the cleaner's tracks/wheels for excessive wear or damage.
- **Poor Suction:**
 - Clean the debris canister/bag thoroughly.

- Check for air leaks in the hose connections or the skimmer.
- Ensure the pool filter is clean and not impeding water flow.
- **Cleaner Getting Stuck:**
 - Adjust the hose length to ensure it's appropriate for your pool size.
 - Check for obstacles in the pool that might be trapping the cleaner.
