Introduction

It features a 2.5-Amp motor and durable steel tines, cultivating an area up to 6.3 inches wide and 6 inches deep.

Safety Information

- **Keep hands and feet away:** Ensure hands and feet are clear of the tines at all times, especially during operation.
- **Secure extension cords:** Use only outdoor-rated extension cords that are in good condition and properly rated for the tool's amperage. Ensure the cord is routed safely to prevent tripping or entanglement.
- **Avoid wet conditions:** Do not operate the cultivator in wet grass or soil, or in the rain.
- **Unplug when not in use:** Always disconnect the power supply before cleaning, adjusting, or servicing the unit.

Product Overview

The Sun Joe TJ599E Corded Electric Garden Cultivator consists of several key components:

Setup

3. **Connect Power:** Connect a suitable outdoor extension cord to the cultivator's power cord. Use the cord retainer to prevent accidental disconnection during use.

Operating Instructions

Before operating, ensure the work area is clear of obstructions and you are wearing appropriate safety gear.

1. **Starting the Cultivator:** Press and hold the safety lock button, then squeeze the trigger switch to start the motor. Release the safety lock button once the motor starts.
2. **Cultivating Technique:** Guide the cultivator slowly over the soil. Allow the tines to dig into the ground. For deeper cultivation, make multiple passes over the same area.
3. **Working in Rows:** Work in straight lines, overlapping slightly with each pass to ensure even cultivation.
4. **Handling Tough Soil:** If the tines encounter very hard or compacted soil, do not force the unit. Lift the cultivator slightly and allow the tines to break up the soil gradually.
5. **Stopping the Cultivator:** Release the trigger switch to stop the motor. Always unplug the unit when finished or before making any adjustments.

Maintenance

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your cultivator.

- **Cleaning:** After each use, unplug the cultivator and clean the tines and housing. Remove any soil, grass, or debris that may have accumulated. Use a stiff brush or cloth.
- **Tine Inspection:** Regularly inspect the steel tines for wear, damage, or bending. Replace damaged tines immediately to maintain performance and safety.
- **Cord Inspection:** Check the power cord and extension cord for any cuts, fraying, or damage. Do not use if damaged.
- **Storage:** Store the cultivator in a dry, protected area away from moisture and extreme temperatures. Protect the equipment from freezing temperatures.

Troubleshooting

If you encounter issues with your cultivator, refer to the following table for common problems and solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Cultivator does not start	No power supply; Safety switch not engaged; Damaged cord	Check power outlet and extension cord; Ensure safety lock button is pressed before trigger; Inspect and replace damaged cords.
Tines not rotating effectively	Debris wrapped around tines; Worn or damaged tines; Overly compacted soil	Unplug and clear debris; Inspect and replace tines if necessary; Make shallower passes or pre-loosen very hard soil.
Excessive vibration	Bent or unbalanced tines; Loose components	Unplug and inspect tines for damage; Check all fasteners for tightness.
