Each pack contains eight miniature skeins, providing a diverse palette for your creative endeavors.

Lion Brand Bonbons are designed for crafters who need small quantities of various colors. The Nature set (Model 601-640) features a harmonious selection of earthy tones. These miniature skeins are convenient for adding details, creating color-block patterns, or experimenting with new shades without committing to full-sized skeins.

SETUP

Before beginning your project, ensure you have all necessary tools, such as knitting needles or crochet hooks, appropriate for the yarn's weight. The Nature Bonbons (Model 601-640) are a Weight Category 2 (Fine) yarn, suitable for US 4/3.5mm knitting needles or F-5/3.75mm crochet hooks.

1. **Unpack:** Carefully remove the miniature skeins from their packaging.
2. **Inspect:** Check each skein for any knots or imperfections.
3. **Prepare Yarn End:** Locate the yarn end from the center or outside of the skein, depending on your preference for working.

4. **Gauge Swatch (Recommended):** Before starting your main project, create a small swatch to check your tension and ensure it matches the recommended gauge for your pattern. This helps achieve the desired size and drape for your finished item.

OPERATING

These Bonbons are designed for detailed work and projects that benefit from small bursts of color. Follow your chosen pattern carefully, paying attention to color changes and stitch counts.

- **Knitting:**

- Recommended Needle Size: US 4 (3.5mm)
- Gauge: 24 stitches x 35 rows = 4 inches x 4 inches (in stockinette stitch)

- **Crocheting:**

- Recommended Hook Size: F-5 (3.75mm)
- Gauge: 19 single crochet x 23 rows = 4 inches x 4 inches (in single crochet)
- **Color Management:** When switching colors, ensure a neat join to prevent unraveling. Weave in ends securely as you go or at the end of the project.
- **Project Ideas:** Consider using these bonbons for small amigurumi figures, decorative edgings, color accents on larger garments, or small accessories like keychains and pompoms.

MAINTENANCE

Proper care will help maintain the quality and longevity of your finished projects made with Lion Brand Bonbons Yarn.

- **Washing:** Machine wash cool on a gentle cycle.
- **Drying:** Lay flat to dry. Do not tumble dry.
- **Bleaching:** Do not bleach.

- **Ironing:** Do not iron.
- **Dry Cleaning:** Dry clean any solvent except Trichloroethylene.
- **Storage:** Store unused yarn in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight to prevent fading and damage.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Encountering issues during your crafting process is common. Here are some tips for common concerns:

- **Running Out of a Specific Color:** Due to the miniature size of Bonbons, it's possible to run out of a color for larger sections. Plan your color usage carefully or consider purchasing multiple packs if your project requires more of a specific shade.
- **Dye Lot Matching:** While efforts are made to ensure consistency, slight variations can occur between dye lots. If your project requires multiple packs of the same color, it is recommended to purchase them together to increase the chance of matching dye lots.
- **Yarn Splitting:** If the yarn splits while working, try adjusting your hook or needle size, or your tension. Sometimes a different tool can make a difference.
- **Tension Issues:** If your project is too tight or too loose, adjust your tension. Practicing with a gauge swatch can help you find the right tension before starting your main piece.
