## 1. INTRODUCTION

---

This manual provides instructions for the JFJ Easy Pro JFJKIT Disc Repair Supply Kit. This kit contains essential consumables designed to be used with a compatible disc repair machine to effectively remove scratches and restore the playability of optical discs such as CDs, DVDs, and game discs.

## 2. KIT CONTENTS

---

The JFJ Easy Pro JFJKIT Disc Repair Supply Kit includes the following components:

- **2 - Easy Pro Buffing Pads:** Used for the final polishing stage of disc repair.
- **1 - Easy Pro Solution #1 (Blue) 4oz:** Abrasive solution for initial scratch removal.
- **1 - Easy Pro Solution #2 (White) 4oz:** Polishing solution for fine scratch removal and disc finishing.
- **1 - Anti-Static Spray 1oz:** Helps prevent static buildup and dust attraction on repaired discs.
- **3 - Coarse Sandpaper:** For addressing deeper scratches.
- **3 - Soft Sandpaper:** For refining surfaces after coarse sanding.
- **3 - Cleaning Cloths:** For wiping and cleaning discs and equipment.

### 3. SETUP

Before using the JFJ Easy Pro Supply Kit, ensure your JFJ disc repair machine is clean and in good working order. Refer to your specific disc repair machine's manual for initial setup and preparation. This supply kit is intended for use with JFJ Easy Pro disc repair systems.

- Unpack all components from the kit.

- Ensure the work area is clean, well-lit, and free from dust.
- Familiarize yourself with the function of each item in the kit.

## 4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

The following steps outline the general procedure for disc repair using the JFJ Easy Pro Supply Kit. Always consult your specific JFJ disc repair machine's manual for detailed operating instructions, as procedures may vary.

### 4.1. Disc Inspection and Preparation

1. Clean the disc surface with a soft, lint-free cloth to remove any loose dust or debris.
2. Inspect the disc for scratches. Categorize them as light, medium, or deep.

### 4.2. Sanding (For Deeper Scratches)

Use sandpaper only if necessary for deep scratches that cannot be removed by buffing alone. Start with the least abrasive option.

1. Attach the appropriate sandpaper (Coarse or Soft) to your disc repair machine as per its instructions.
2. Apply a small amount of Solution #1 (Blue) to the disc surface or sandpaper, if recommended by your machine's manual.
3. Process the disc according to your machine's sanding cycle.
4. Clean the disc thoroughly after sanding to remove all abrasive residue.

### 4.3. Buffing and Polishing

This stage uses the buffing pads and solutions to remove fine scratches and polish the disc surface.

1. Attach a clean Easy Pro Buffing Pad to your disc repair machine.
2. Apply a small amount of Solution #1 (Blue) to the disc surface.
3. Run the disc through the machine's buffing cycle with Solution #1.
4. Clean the disc and buffing pad.
5. Attach a fresh, clean Easy Pro Buffing Pad.
6. Apply a small amount of Solution #2 (White) to the disc surface.
7. Run the disc through the machine's final polishing cycle with Solution #2.

### 4.4. Final Cleaning and Anti-Static Treatment

1. After the final polishing, thoroughly clean the disc with one of the provided cleaning cloths to remove all solution residue.
2. Lightly spray the Anti-Static Spray onto a clean cloth (not directly onto the disc) and gently wipe the disc surface. This helps reduce static charge and prevents dust attraction.
3. Inspect the disc under good lighting to ensure all scratches are removed and the surface is clear.

## 5. MAINTENANCE

---

Proper maintenance of your supply kit components ensures optimal performance and longevity.

- **Buffing Pads:** Clean buffing pads after each use by rinsing them with water and allowing them to air dry completely. Replace pads when they show signs of wear or become ineffective.

- **Cleaning Cloths:** Wash cleaning cloths regularly to remove residue. Use separate cloths for different solutions to avoid cross-contamination.
- **Solutions:** Store solution bottles tightly capped in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight.
- **Sandpaper:** Dispose of used sandpaper. Do not reuse sandpaper as it can introduce new scratches.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

---

If you encounter issues during the disc repair process, consider the following:

- **Disc still scratched:** Ensure sufficient solution was applied. Verify that the correct buffing pad or sandpaper was used for the scratch depth. Repeat the process if necessary, focusing on the affected areas.
- **Hazy disc surface:** This can occur if solution residue is not completely removed. Thoroughly clean the disc with a fresh cleaning cloth and Anti-Static Spray. Ensure buffing pads are clean.
- **Machine not performing:** Refer to your disc repair machine's specific manual for troubleshooting mechanical or electrical issues.
- **Solutions drying too quickly:** Ensure you are working in a controlled environment, away from excessive heat or airflow. Apply enough solution to keep the disc surface lubricated during the repair cycle.
