## INTRODUCTION

This manual provides instructions for the assembly, operation, and maintenance of your Bestway 52008B-03 Cottage Play House. Please read all instructions carefully before use to ensure safe and enjoyable play.

## SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

The Bestway Cottage Play House features an easy-to-assemble plug-in system, requiring no tools for setup. Follow these steps to assemble your playhouse:

1. Unpack all components from the box and ensure all parts are present.
2. Carefully unfold the vinyl playhouse structure.
3. Connect the frame pieces using the plug-in system. Ensure each connection is secure.
4. Once the frame is assembled, drape the vinyl cover over the frame, aligning the openings for the door and windows.
5. Secure the vinyl cover to the frame as instructed in the packaging (if specific attachment points exist).

The assembled dimensions of the playhouse are approximately 102 cm (length) x 76 cm (width) x 114 cm (height).

## **OPERATION AND USE**

This playhouse is designed for children aged 3 to 10 years. It provides a fun and imaginative space for play.

- The playhouse features a foldable door with a holder, allowing it to be kept open or closed during play.
- Supervise children during play to ensure their safety.
- Ensure the playhouse is placed on a flat, stable surface away from hazards.

## **MAINTENANCE**

To ensure the longevity of your Bestway Cottage Play House, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** Wipe down the durable 0.12 mm vinyl surfaces with a damp cloth and mild soap. Rinse thoroughly and allow to air dry completely before storage. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- **Storage:** When not in use, disassemble the playhouse and store it in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Repairs:** The playhouse includes self-adhesive repair patches for minor punctures or tears in the vinyl. Clean the damaged area, apply the patch firmly, and allow it to cure according to the patch instructions.
- **Inspection:** Regularly inspect the playhouse for any signs of wear, damage, or loose connections. Address any issues promptly to prevent further damage or safety hazards.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Playhouse feels unstable after assembly.	Connections not fully secured or uneven ground.	Ensure all plug-in connections are firmly seated. Move the playhouse to a flat, level surface.
Frame tubes do not fit into plastic connectors.	Misalignment or slight manufacturing variation.	Apply gentle, even pressure. Ensure the tube is correctly oriented. If persistent, check for any obstructions within the connector.
Vinyl cover does not fit correctly.	Incorrect orientation or frame not fully assembled.	Verify the frame is completely and correctly assembled. Re-orient the vinyl cover to match the frame structure.
