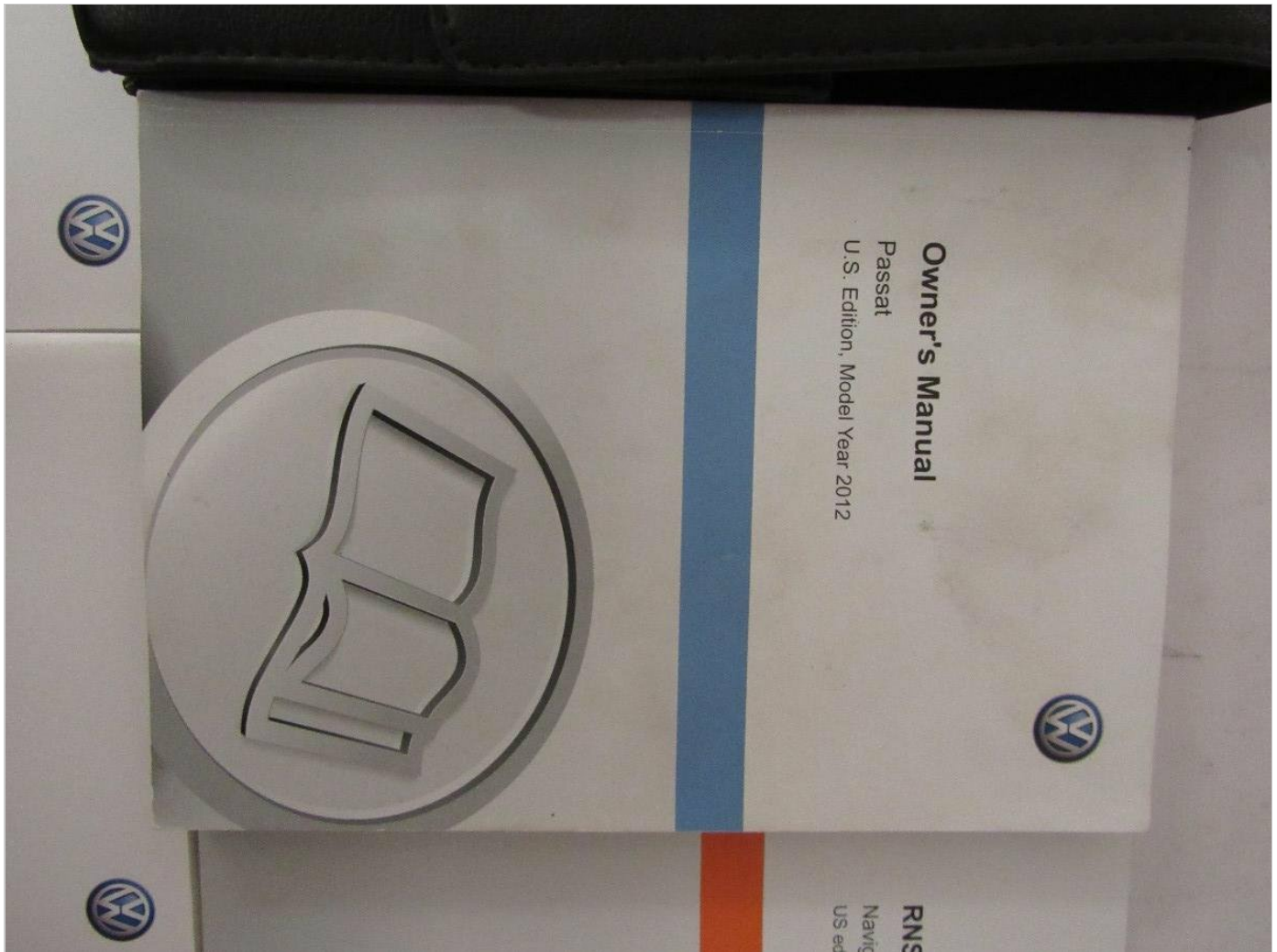

INITIAL SETUP AND FAMILIARIZATION

Before driving, it is important to familiarize yourself with the vehicle's basic controls and settings. This section covers initial adjustments and key features.

Adjusting Seating and Mirrors

The mobile phone package allows for hands-free communication and media streaming. Consult the specific manual for pairing and operation.

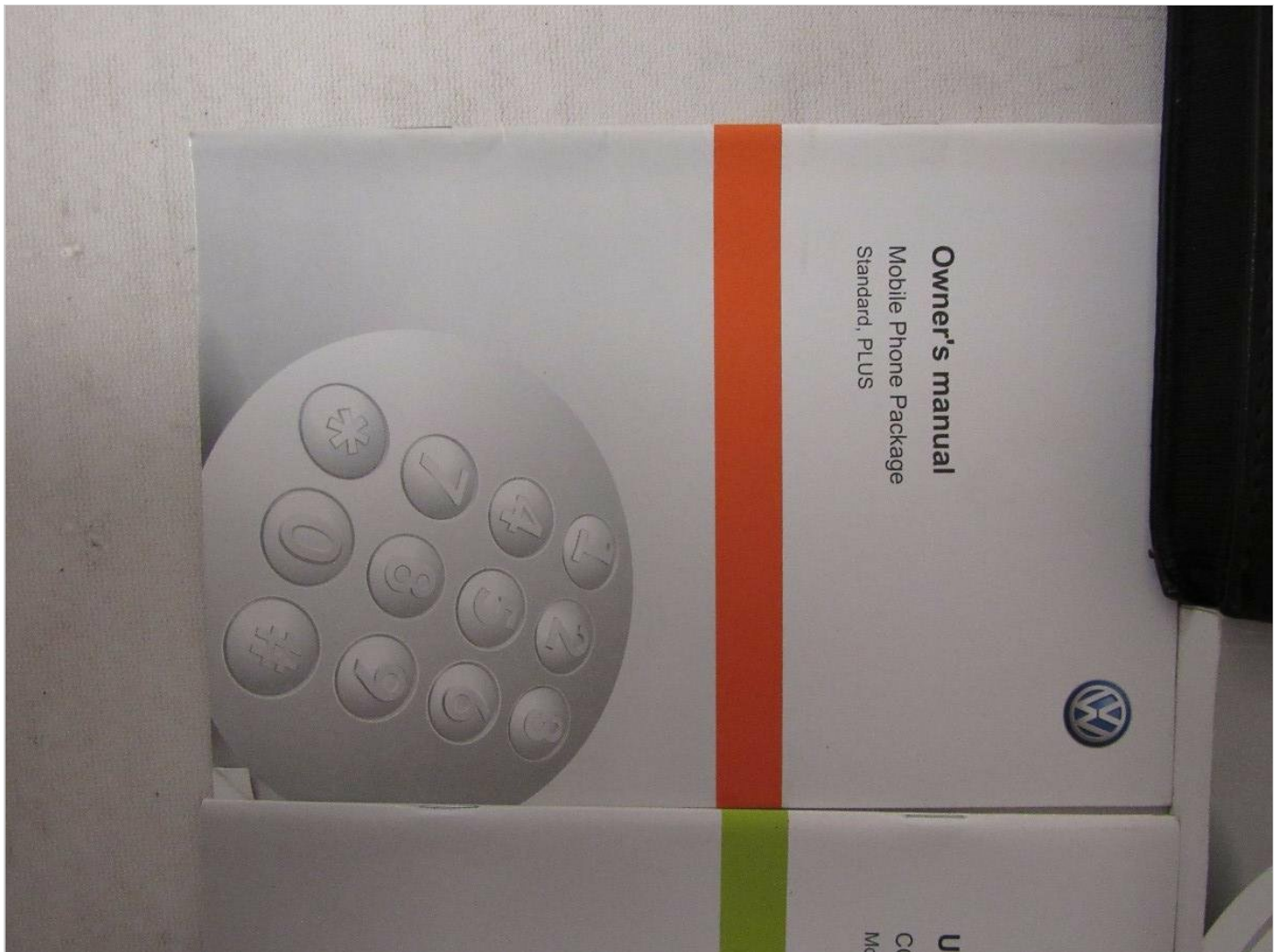


Image: The cover of the Mobile Phone Package Owner's Manual, providing instructions for using the vehicle's integrated phone system.

Warning Lights

- **Oil Pressure Warning:** Stop the vehicle immediately and check the oil level. Do not drive with low oil pressure.
- **Brake System Warning:** Indicates a fault in the brake system. Drive cautiously to a service center or have the vehicle towed.

Flat Tire

If you experience a flat tire, safely pull over to the side of the road. Refer to the manual for instructions on using the spare tire and jack, or contact roadside assistance.

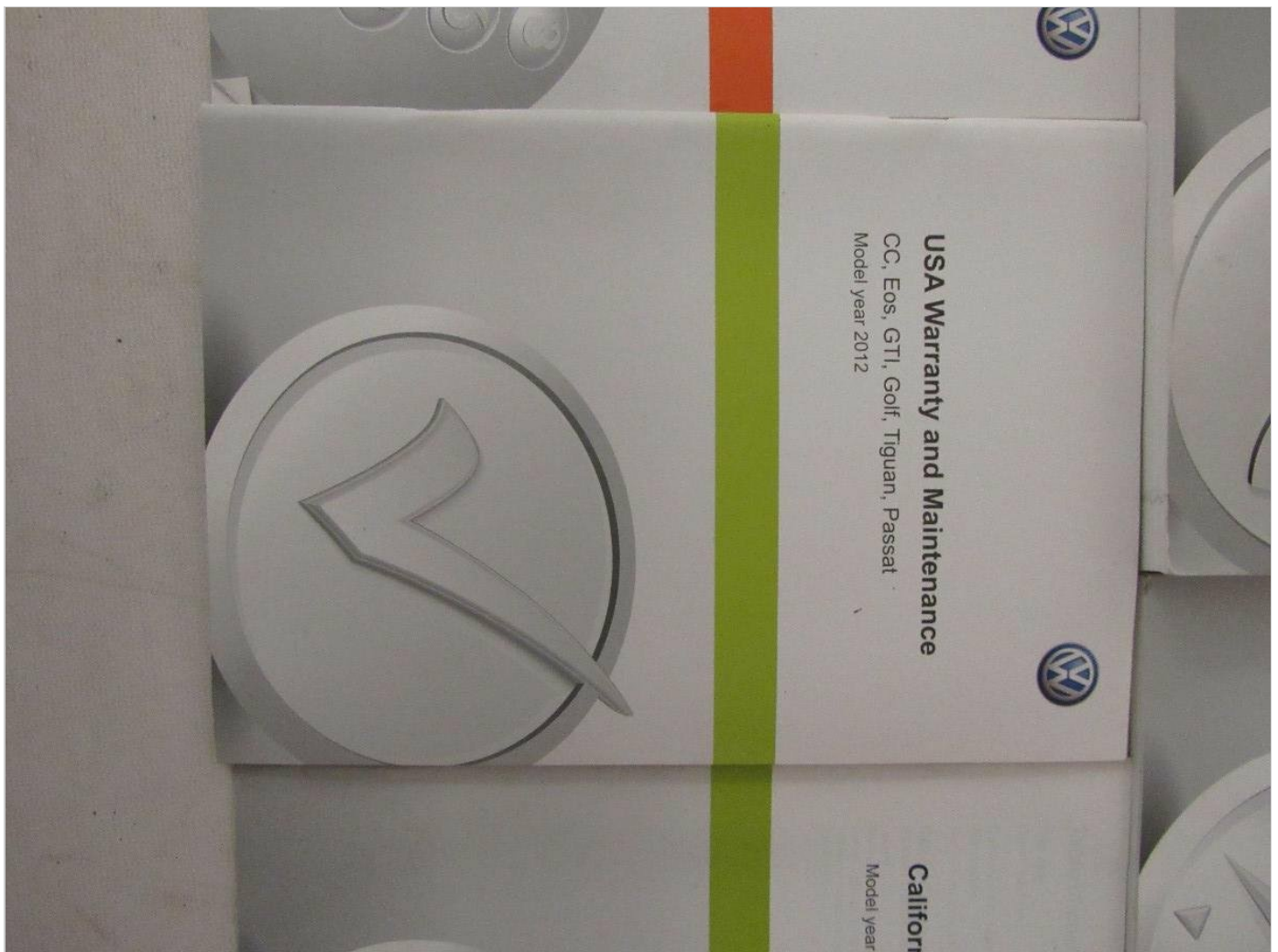


Image: The cover of the USA Warranty and Maintenance manual, applicable to 2012 Volkswagen models including the Passat.

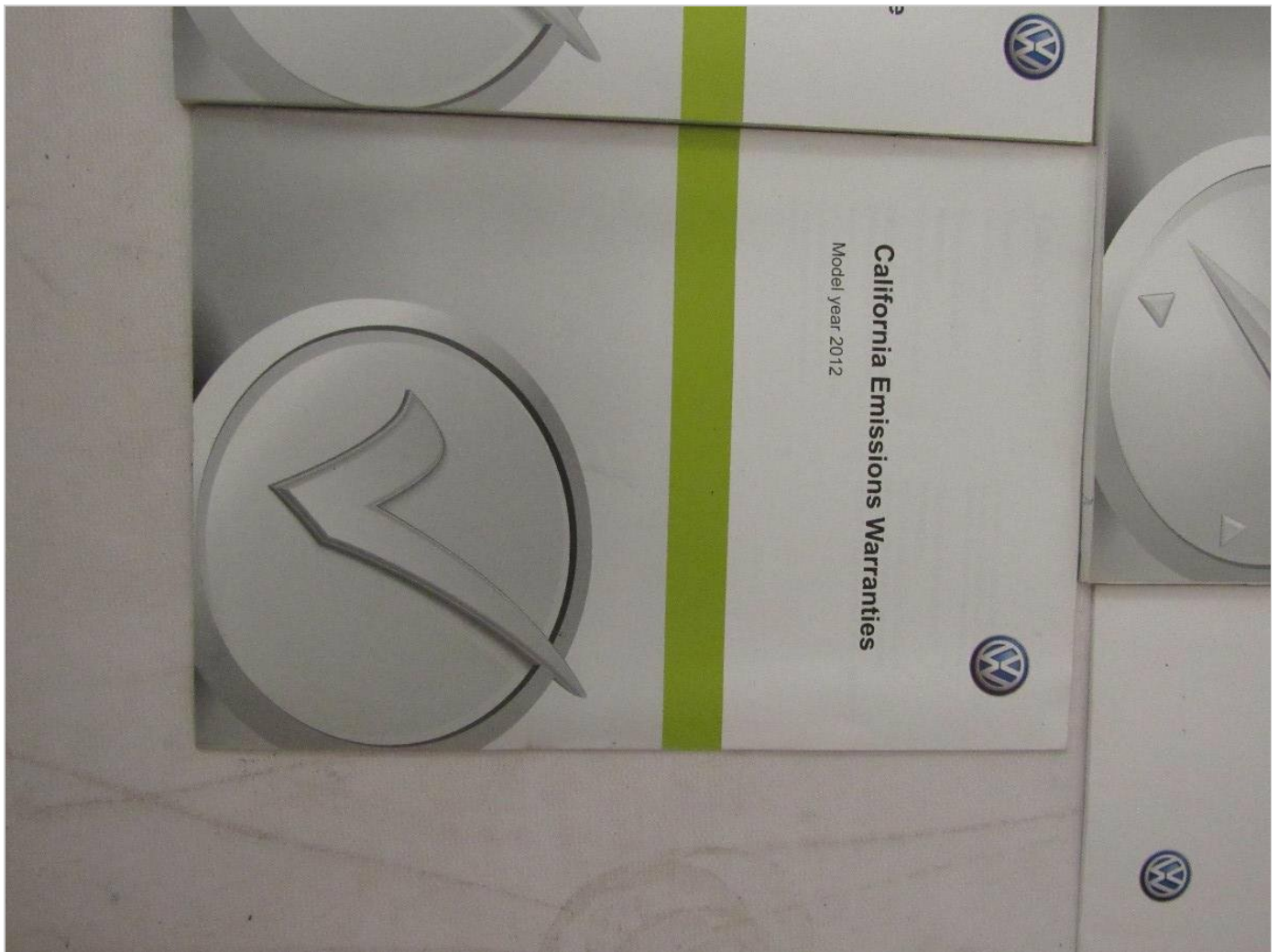


Image: The cover of the California Emissions Warranties manual, detailing specific warranty information for vehicles sold in California for the 2012 model year.
