INTRODUCTION

The Logitech K800 Wireless Illuminated Keyboard is designed for enhanced typing comfort and visibility. It features laser-etched, backlit keys that adjust automatically to ambient light conditions. The PerfectStroke key system ensures fluid and quiet keystrokes, while the Logitech Incurve keys provide proper finger positioning. This keyboard offers flexible recharging via a micro-USB cable, eliminating the need for disposable batteries and allowing use during charging. Its advanced 2.4 GHz wireless technology provides a reliable, long-range connection with minimal delays or interference. The included Logitech Unifying receiver allows for easy connection and the addition of compatible mice and keyboards.

WHAT'S IN THE BOX

Your Logitech K800 Wireless Illuminated Keyboard package includes the following items:

SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

- Charge the Keyboard:** Before initial use, connect the micro-USB charging cable to the keyboard and a USB power source (e.g., computer USB port, USB wall adapter). Allow the keyboard to charge fully. The battery indicator lights will provide status.
- Connect the Unifying Receiver:** Insert the tiny Logitech Unifying receiver into an available USB port on your computer. The receiver is designed to be small enough to remain in your laptop without risk of damage or loss.
- Power On:** Turn on the keyboard using the power switch, typically located on the top right edge of the keyboard.
- Automatic Connection:** The keyboard should automatically connect to the Unifying receiver. If not, you may need to use the Logitech Unifying Software (available for download from the Logitech website) to pair the devices.
- Install Software (Optional):** For advanced customization of function keys and other settings, download and install the Logitech Options software from the official Logitech website.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Backlighting

The K800 features smart backlighting that automatically adjusts to the ambient light in your environment. An integrated ambient light sensor detects the surrounding light levels and brightens or dims the key backlighting accordingly. The backlighting also activates when your hands approach the keyboard and turns off when you move away, conserving battery life.

- Manual Brightness Adjustment:** You can manually adjust the backlighting brightness using the dedicated brightness keys (usually F5 and F6) on the keyboard.
- Proximity Detection:** The keyboard uses proximity sensors to detect your hands, illuminating the keys as you approach and dimming them when you move away.

Typing Experience

The PerfectStroke key system and Logitech Incurve keys are designed for a comfortable and efficient typing experience. The keys are quiet and provide a smooth, responsive feel.

Media Keys and Function Keys

The keyboard includes dedicated media keys and customizable function keys (F1-F12) for quick access to various controls and applications. These can be configured using the Logitech Options software.

- **Media Controls:** Play/pause, volume up/down, mute, and track navigation.
- **Customizable Functions:** Assign specific actions or shortcuts to the F-keys for personalized workflow.

Charging the Keyboard

The K800 uses a rechargeable battery. When the battery is low, the battery indicator light will signal the need for charging. Connect the micro-USB cable to the keyboard and a power source. You can continue to use the keyboard while it is charging.

- **Battery Life:** A full charge can provide up to 10 days of battery life, depending on usage and backlighting intensity.
- **Charging Indicator:** The battery indicator lights will show charging status and when the battery is full.

MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your Logitech K800 keyboard, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, lint-free cloth slightly dampened with water or a mild cleaning solution to wipe the surface of the keyboard. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- **Dust Removal:** Use compressed air to remove dust and debris from between the keys.
- **Storage:** When not in use for extended periods, store the keyboard in a cool, dry place.
- **Avoid Spills:** Keep liquids away from the keyboard to prevent damage.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Logitech K800 keyboard, try the following troubleshooting steps:

- **Keyboard Not Responding:**

- Ensure the keyboard is powered on.
- Check if the Unifying receiver is securely plugged into a USB port on your computer.
- Verify the keyboard battery is charged. Connect the charging cable if needed.
- Try plugging the Unifying receiver into a different USB port.
- If using a USB hub, try connecting the receiver directly to the computer.

- **Backlighting Not Working or Dim:**

- Ensure the keyboard is powered on and charged.
- Check ambient light conditions; the backlighting adjusts automatically.
- Manually adjust brightness using the F5 and F6 keys.

- **Connection Issues:**

- Re-pair the keyboard with the Unifying receiver using the Logitech Unifying Software.
- Move the keyboard closer to the Unifying receiver to rule out range issues.
- Avoid sources of wireless interference (e.g., other 2.4 GHz devices, Wi-Fi routers).

- **Keys Not Functioning Correctly:**

- Clean around and under the affected keys to remove any debris.
- Ensure no software conflicts are present. Try the keyboard on another computer if possible.
