INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Broyhill Primo Vista Queen Panel Bed. This manual provides essential information for the assembly, use, and maintenance of your new bed. Please read these instructions carefully before beginning assembly and retain them for future reference.

SAFETY INFORMATION

Always follow basic safety precautions when assembling and using this product to reduce the risk of injury or damage.

- Ensure all parts are present and undamaged before assembly. Do not use if any parts are missing or broken.
- Assemble the bed on a soft, clean surface to prevent scratching.
- Use only the hardware provided or specified by the manufacturer.
- Periodically check all connections and tighten as necessary.
- Do not allow children to climb on the bed frame or use it as a play structure.
- This bed is designed for use with a standard queen-size mattress and foundation (box spring or slats, depending on design). Ensure proper support for your mattress.

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Assembly of the Primo Vista Queen Panel Bed requires two adults. Please follow these steps carefully.

Package Contents:

- Headboard (1)
- Footboard (1)
- Side Rails (2)
- Slats (or support system, quantity varies)
- Hardware Pack (bolts, washers, nuts, Allen wrench)

Tools Required:

- Included Allen Wrench
- Phillips Head Screwdriver (not always needed, depends on slat attachment)

Assembly Steps:

1. Unpack all components and lay them out on a clean, soft surface to prevent damage. Verify all parts are present against the package contents list.
2. Attach the side rails to the headboard. Align the pre-drilled holes on the side rails with the corresponding holes on the headboard posts. Insert bolts and tighten securely with the Allen wrench. Do not overtighten.
3. Attach the side rails to the footboard. Repeat the process from step 2, connecting the other end of the side rails to the footboard posts. Ensure all connections are snug and the frame is stable.
4. Install the slats. Depending on your model, the slats may attach directly to the side rails with screws or rest on support ledges. Distribute the slats evenly across the frame and secure them if required. This provides the necessary support for your mattress.
5. Place your mattress and foundation (if applicable) onto the assembled bed frame.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Primo Vista Queen Panel Bed is designed for stationary use as a sleeping surface. No specific "operating" procedures are required beyond proper assembly and placement.

- Ensure the bed is placed on a level surface to prevent wobbling or instability.
- Do not drag the bed when moving it; lift it to prevent damage to the frame or your flooring.
- The bed is designed to support the weight of a standard queen-size mattress, foundation, and occupants. Do not exceed reasonable weight limits.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Proper care will help maintain the beauty and longevity of your Primo Vista Queen Panel Bed.

- **Cleaning:** Dust regularly with a soft, dry cloth. For deeper cleaning, wipe with a damp cloth and mild soap, then dry immediately. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners, as these can damage the finish.
- **Spills:** Blot spills immediately with a clean, dry cloth.
- **Sunlight Exposure:** Avoid prolonged exposure to direct sunlight, which can cause fading or discoloration of the wood finish.
- **Humidity:** Maintain a consistent humidity level in your room. Extreme fluctuations can cause wood to expand or contract, potentially leading to cracks or warping.
- **Hardware Check:** Periodically check all bolts and screws to ensure they remain tight. Retighten as needed to maintain stability.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Primo Vista Queen Panel Bed, refer to the following common problems and solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Bed is wobbly or unstable.	Loose hardware connections. Uneven floor.	Check and tighten all bolts and screws. Move the bed to a level surface or use shims under the legs to stabilize.
Squeaking noises.	Loose connections. Friction between parts.	Tighten all hardware. Apply a small amount of paraffin wax or silicone spray to points of friction between wood components or where slats meet rails.
Mattress sagging in the middle.	Insufficient slat support. Damaged slats.	Ensure slats are evenly spaced and properly secured. If slats are damaged, replace them. Consider adding more slats or a center support leg if your model allows.
