Introduction

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the Step2 Whisper Ride II Buggy Kids Push Car, model 823000. This durable ride-on toy is designed for toddlers aged 1.5 to 4 years, with a maximum weight capacity of 50 lbs. It features "whisper ride" wheels for smooth operation, an adjustable seat belt for safety, a functional horn and steering wheel for interactive play, convenient cup holders, and under-hood storage. Please read this manual thoroughly before assembly and use to ensure safe and correct operation.

SAFETY INFORMATION

WARNING: CHOKING HAZARD - Small parts. Sharp points. Adult assembly required.

- Always ensure adult supervision when the product is in use.
- Ensure the child is securely fastened with the adjustable seat belt before use.
- Do not use near stairs, hills, roadways, or swimming pools.
- Inspect the product regularly for loose parts, damage, or wear. Discontinue use if any damage is found.
- Maximum weight capacity: 50 lbs (22.7 kg).
- Recommended age: 18 months to 4 years.

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Adult assembly is required. Please follow these general steps. Refer to the included hardware for specific fasteners. A rubber mallet and a sturdy screwdriver may be helpful.

1. **Attach Wheels:** Securely attach all four wheels to the car body using the provided axles and caps. A rubber mallet may be needed to fully seat the wheel caps for a tight fit.

- 2. **Install Steering Wheel and Dashboard:** Attach the steering wheel to the dashboard console. Then, secure the dashboard assembly to the front of the car body using the appropriate screws. Note that some screw holes may not be pre-drilled, requiring firm pressure during installation.
- 3. **Secure Seat Belt:** Install the adjustable seat belt assembly into the designated slots in the car seat. Ensure it is firmly attached and functions correctly.

4. **Attach Push Handle:** Insert the push handle into the rear of the car body. Secure it with the provided hardware (e.g., bolts and nuts). Ensure the handle is stable and does not wobble. The handle is designed to fold down for compact storage and transport.

5. **Install Handle Cup Holder:** Attach the yellow cup holder to the push handle as shown in the product images.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

- **Child Placement:** Carefully place the child into the seat. Ensure they are seated comfortably and correctly.
- Fasten Seat Belt: Always fasten the adjustable seat belt securely around the child. Check that it is snug but not too tight.
- **Pushing the Car:** Use the rear push handle to guide the car. The "whisper ride" wheels are designed for smooth and quiet movement on various surfaces.
- **Turning:** To make turns, apply gentle downward pressure on the push handle to slightly lift the front wheels. This allows for easier steering and maneuvering.
- Interactive Features: The steering wheel is functional, and the car includes a working horn for interactive play.

• **Storage:** Utilize the under-hood storage compartment for snacks, small toys, or other essentials. The car also features two cup holders on the dashboard for the child's beverages.

• **Folding Handle:** For transport or compact storage, the push handle can be folded down underneath the car body.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

- **Cleaning:** To clean the car, simply wipe surfaces with a disinfectant wipe or a mild household cleaner and a damp cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners.
- **Inspection:** Regularly inspect all parts for wear, damage, or loose fasteners. Pay close attention to the wheels, axles, seat belt, and handle connections.
- **Storage:** Store the car in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight when not in use to prolong its lifespan and maintain color integrity. The handle can be folded for more compact storage.
- **Durability:** The car is constructed from durable, double-walled plastic designed to resist chipping, fading, cracking, and peeling, ensuring years of use.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution	
---------	----------------	----------	--

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Wheels are wobbly or come off.	Wheel caps not fully seated or damaged.	Ensure wheel caps are securely pushed onto the axles. Use a rubber mallet if necessary. If damaged, contact customer support for replacement parts.
Difficulty turning the car.	Wheels are fixed and not designed to pivot like a stroller.	Apply gentle downward pressure on the push handle to slightly lift the front wheels, then pivot the car in the desired direction.
Push handle feels loose.	Mounting hardware for the handle is not tightened.	Check and tighten all bolts and nuts securing the push handle to the car body.
Horn not working.	Possible internal mechanism issue or obstruction.	Ensure no debris is obstructing the horn mechanism. If the issue persists, contact customer support.
