# Bose FreeSpace 3 Surface Satellite Speakers User Manual

## INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the proper installation, operation, and maintenance of your Bose FreeSpace 3 Surface Satellite Speakers. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the product to ensure optimal performance and safety.

## SETUP AND INSTALLATION

---

Proper setup is crucial for optimal sound performance. These speakers are designed for surface mounting.

### 1. Choosing a Location

- Select a location that provides clear sound dispersion and is structurally sound to support the speaker's weight.

- Avoid placing speakers near heat sources or in direct sunlight.
- Ensure adequate space for wiring and ventilation.

## 2. Mounting the Speakers

1. Attach the mounting brackets to the desired surface using appropriate hardware (not included). Ensure the brackets are securely fastened.
2. Carefully attach the FreeSpace 3 satellite speakers to the installed mounting brackets.
3. Adjust the speaker angle for optimal sound direction.

## 3. Wiring Connections

Connect the speakers to a compatible amplifier or audio system. Ensure the system is powered off before making any connections.

- Use high-quality speaker wire.
- Connect the positive (+) terminal of the speaker to the positive (+) terminal of the amplifier.
- Connect the negative (-) terminal of the speaker to the negative (-) terminal of the amplifier.
- Ensure all connections are secure to prevent short circuits.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once installed and connected, your Bose FreeSpace 3 speakers are ready for operation.

1. **Power On:** Turn on your amplifier or audio system.
2. **Volume Control:** Start with the volume at a low level and gradually increase it to your desired listening level.
3. **Audio Source:** Select your preferred audio source (e.g., laptop, television, music player).
4. **Voice Control (if applicable):** If your system supports voice control and is configured, you may use voice commands to manage playback. Refer to your amplifier's manual for specific voice control setup.

*Note:* These speakers are designed to reproduce mid and upper range audio frequencies. For full-range sound, they are typically paired with a subwoofer (sold separately).

## MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe the speaker surfaces. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Dust Removal:** Gently remove dust from the speaker grilles using a soft brush or vacuum cleaner with a brush attachment.
- **Environmental Conditions:** Keep speakers away from excessive moisture, extreme temperatures, and direct sunlight.
- **Cable Inspection:** Periodically check speaker cables for any signs of wear or damage. Replace damaged cables immediately.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your FreeSpace 3 speakers, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
---------	----------------	----------

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No Sound	Power not on Incorrect wiring Source not selected Volume too low	Ensure amplifier is powered on. Check all speaker wire connections (positive to positive, negative to negative). Verify the correct audio source is selected on your amplifier. Increase volume gradually.
Distorted Sound	Volume too high Damaged speaker wire Incorrect impedance match	Reduce volume. Inspect and replace damaged speaker wires. Consult your amplifier's manual for compatible impedance.
One Speaker Not Working	Loose connection Faulty speaker wire	Check connections for the non-working speaker. Swap speaker wires with a working speaker to isolate the issue.
