



## 1. INTRODUCTION

## 2. PRODUCT FEATURES

The Polaroid Zink Premium Photo Paper offers several key features for an enhanced printing experience:

- **Peel-Off & Sticky-Backed:** Each photo has an adhesive backing, allowing it to be used as a sticker for scrapbooks, projects, or decorations.

## 3. COMPATIBILITY

This Polaroid Zink 2x3 Premium Photo Paper is compatible with a range of Polaroid instant print devices, including:

- Polaroid Mint Camera
- Polaroid Snap Instant Print Camera
- Polaroid Snap Touch Instant Print Camera
- Polaroid Socialmatic Camera
- Polaroid Zip Photo Printers

Ensure your device is compatible with 2x3 inch ZINK photo paper for optimal performance.

## 4. SETUP: LOADING PHOTO PAPER

Properly loading the photo paper is crucial for successful printing. Always refer to your specific camera or printer's instruction manual for detailed loading procedures, as steps may vary slightly by model. General guidelines are provided below:

- 1. Open the Paper Tray:** Locate and open the paper tray or compartment on your compatible Polaroid device.
- 2. Prepare the Paper Pack:** Remove the Zink photo paper from its protective packaging. Each pack typically includes a blue calibration sheet.
- 3. Load the Paper:** Insert the stack of photo paper into the tray. Ensure the glossy side of the paper is facing upwards (or as indicated by your device's manual). The blue calibration sheet should be placed at the bottom of the stack, with its barcode facing downwards. This sheet is essential for the printer to calibrate color and optimize print quality.
- 4. Close the Tray:** Securely close the paper tray or compartment. The device may perform a brief calibration cycle.

## 5. OPERATING: PRINTING PHOTOS

---

Once the Zink photo paper is loaded, you can begin printing from your compatible device. The printing process is generally straightforward:

- 1. Select Image:** Choose the image you wish to print from your camera's gallery or connected smartphone/device.
- 2. Initiate Print:** Follow your device's instructions to send the print command. The device will process the image and begin printing.
- 3. Retrieve Print:** The printed photo will emerge from the device. Allow a few moments for the print to fully develop and cool, though ZINK prints are dry to the touch immediately.
- 4. Utilize Adhesive Backing:** If desired, peel off the protective layer from the back of the photo to reveal the adhesive surface, allowing you to stick the photo onto various surfaces.

## 6. MAINTENANCE: PAPER AND PHOTO CARE

---

To ensure the longevity and quality of your Zink photo paper and printed images, follow these care guidelines:

- **Storage:** Store unused photo paper in its original sealed packaging in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Handling:** Avoid touching the printable surface of the paper before printing to prevent smudges or fingerprints.
- **Print Protection:** While Zink prints are durable, avoid prolonged exposure to harsh chemicals, excessive moisture, or direct, intense sunlight to prevent potential fading over many years.
- **Adhesive Backing:** When using the adhesive backing, ensure the surface you are sticking the photo to is clean and dry for best adhesion.

## 7. TROUBLESHOOTING

---

If you encounter issues while using your Polaroid Zink photo paper, consider the following common solutions:

- **Poor Print Quality/Color Issues:**
  - Ensure the blue calibration sheet was loaded correctly with the barcode facing down.
  - Check that the paper is not expired or damaged.
  - Clean the print head of your device according to its manual, if applicable.
- **Paper Not Feeding:**
  - Verify the paper is loaded correctly and not jammed.
  - Ensure the paper tray is not overloaded or underloaded.
- **No Print Output:**
  - Confirm your device has sufficient battery power.
  - Check the connection between your device and the printer (if applicable).
  - Ensure there is paper loaded in the device.




