1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Schuller Paint Grid (Model 14189) is a practical accessory designed to assist in painting tasks. It is specifically sized at 10 x 17 cm and comes in a pack of 10 units. This grid is used to remove excess paint from brushes or rollers, ensuring an even application and preventing drips. Its durable plastic construction makes it lightweight and easy to clean.




Image 1: The Schuller 10 x 17 cm paint grid, showing its red color, grid pattern, integrated handle, and a small hook for attachment.

2. SETUP AND PREPARATION

- 3. Apply Paint: Proceed to apply the paint to your desired surface.
- 4. **Re-dip as Needed:** Repeat the process of dipping and removing excess paint as required throughout your painting task.

4. CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Proper cleaning and storage will extend the life of your paint grid.

- Immediate Cleaning: Clean the paint grid immediately after each use, before the paint dries.
- Water-Based Paints: For water-based paints, rinse the grid thoroughly under running water. Use a brush or sponge to remove any stubborn paint residue from the grid squares.
- Oil-Based Paints: For oil-based paints, clean the grid with an appropriate paint thinner or solvent as recommended by the paint manufacturer. Ensure proper ventilation and follow safety guidelines when using solvents.
- Drying: Allow the grid to air dry completely before storing.
- Storage: Store the clean, dry paint grids in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

Common issues and their solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Grid slips in bucket.	Hook not properly engaged or bucket rim is too thick/thin.	Ensure the hook is securely resting on the bucket rim. Use with compatible bucket sizes.
Paint dries on grid.	Grid not cleaned immediately after use.	Clean the grid promptly after finishing your painting task. For dried paint, soak in appropriate solvent before scrubbing.
Ineffective paint removal.	Incorrect technique or grid is clogged.	Ensure you are dragging the brush/roller firmly across the grid. Clean the grid thoroughly to remove any clogs.
