1. INTRODUCTION

4. SETUP

Follow these steps to connect your Fujitsu KB410 keyboard to your computer:

1. **Power Off:** Ensure your computer is completely powered off before connecting the keyboard.
2. **Locate PS/2 Port:** Identify the PS/2 keyboard port on your computer. This port is typically purple and circular.
3. **Connect Keyboard:** Carefully align the PS/2 connector of the keyboard with the PS/2 keyboard port on your computer and push it in firmly until it is secure.

4. **Power On:** Turn on your computer. The operating system should automatically detect and install the necessary drivers for the keyboard. No additional software installation is typically required for PS/2 keyboards.

5. OPERATING

Keyboard is not responding.	• Ensure the PS/2 cable is securely connected to the computer's PS/2 keyboard port. • Restart your computer. • Try connecting the keyboard to a different PS/2 port or another computer to rule out a port issue.
Certain keys are not working or are sticking.	• Clean the affected keys using compressed air to remove any debris. • If the issue persists, the key mechanism might be damaged.
Num Lock, Caps Lock, or Scroll Lock indicators are not working.	• Press the respective key (Num Lock, Caps Lock, Scroll Lock) to toggle its status. • If the indicators still do not light up, ensure the keyboard is properly connected and the computer is powered on.
