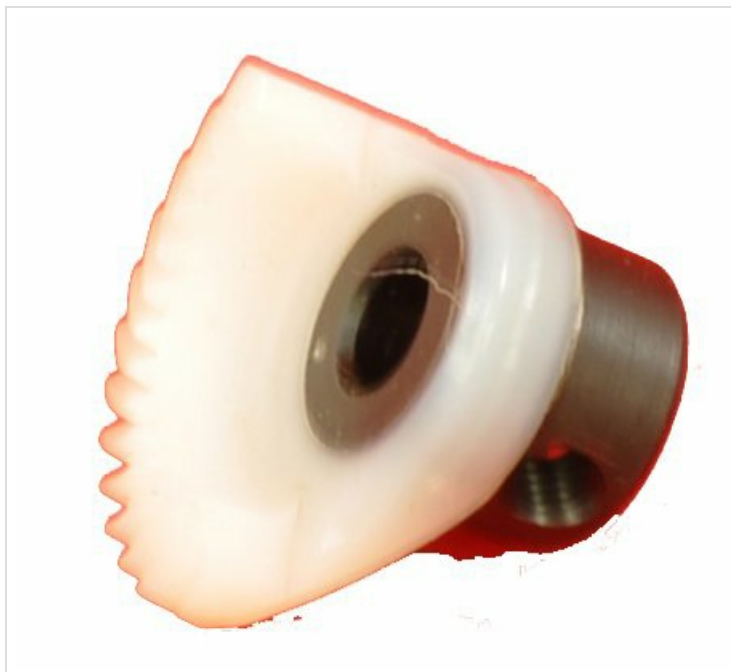

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

5. **Install the New Gear:** Position the new Necchi 640013008 gear in the exact orientation as the old one. Secure it with the original screws, clips, or pins. Ensure it rotates freely without binding.

FUNCTION AND PURPOSE

The hook shaft shuttle gear is an integral part of the sewing machine's lower mechanism. Its primary function is to transmit rotational motion, ensuring the precise movement of the hook and shuttle assembly. This synchronized movement is essential for forming consistent stitches by catching the needle thread and looping it around the bobbin thread.

MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance of your sewing machine's internal gears can extend its lifespan and ensure smooth operation.

- **Cleaning:** Periodically remove lint and debris from around the gear mechanism using a small brush or compressed air.
- **Lubrication:** Apply a small amount of high-quality sewing machine oil to moving parts as recommended by your sewing machine's manufacturer. Avoid over-lubrication, which can attract dust.
- **Inspection:** Regularly inspect the gear for signs of wear, cracks, or missing teeth. Replace the gear if any damage is observed.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues after installing the new gear, consider the following:

- **Machine Not Moving:** Ensure the gear is correctly seated and not binding against other components. Check for any obstructions.
- **Unusual Noises:** Grinding or clicking sounds may indicate improper installation, misalignment, or a damaged gear. Re-inspect the installation.
- **Stitch Problems:** If the machine is skipping stitches or forming irregular stitches, the timing might be off. This is a common issue after replacing gears. Consult your sewing machine's service manual for timing adjustment procedures or seek professional assistance.
- **Gear Does Not Fit:** Double-check the compatibility list and your sewing machine's model number. Ensure you have the correct part.
