1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the proper use, installation, and maintenance of your bobbins.

2. COMPATIBILITY

These plastic bobbins are compatible with the following sewing machine models:

3. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Proper bobbin setup is crucial for smooth sewing. Follow these general steps:

1. **Winding the Bobbin:** Refer to your sewing machine's specific instruction manual for detailed steps on

how to wind thread onto the bobbin. Ensure the thread is wound evenly and not too tightly or too loosely.

2. **Inserting the Bobbin:** Open the bobbin case or access panel on your sewing machine. Insert the wound bobbin according to your machine's design (top-loading or front-loading). Ensure the thread is correctly routed through any tension springs or guides as specified by your machine's manual.
3. **Drawing Up the Bobbin Thread:** Close the bobbin case/panel. Lower the needle to pick up the bobbin thread, then pull both the bobbin and upper threads to the back of the machine before starting to sew.

4. OPERATING GUIDELINES

Once installed, the bobbins function as part of your sewing machine's lower thread mechanism. Ensure the following for optimal operation:

- **Thread Matching:** Use the same type and weight of thread for both the bobbin and the upper needle for balanced stitches.
- **Tension Adjustment:** If stitches appear uneven, adjust the bobbin tension (if your machine allows) or the upper thread tension according to your sewing machine's manual.
- **Regular Checks:** Periodically check the bobbin for remaining thread to avoid running out mid-seam.

5. MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and proper function of your bobbins:

- **Cleaning:** Occasionally wipe bobbins with a soft, dry cloth to remove any lint or dust buildup.
- **Storage:** Store unused bobbins in a clean, dry container or bobbin box to prevent dust accumulation and tangling of threads.
- **Inspection:** Before each use, inspect bobbins for any cracks, deformities, or rough edges that could snag thread. Replace damaged bobbins immediately.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues related to bobbin performance, consider the following:

- **Thread Jamming/Tangling:**
 - Ensure the bobbin is inserted correctly and the thread is properly routed through all guides.
 - Check for excess lint or broken threads in the bobbin case area.
 - Verify that the bobbin is not overfilled or unevenly wound.
- **Skipped Stitches or Uneven Tension:**
 - Confirm that the bobbin thread matches the upper thread in type and weight.
 - Adjust upper thread tension first. If issues persist, consult your machine's manual for bobbin tension adjustment.
 - Ensure the bobbin is not damaged or warped.
