1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the BLACK+DECKER dustbuster 20V Cordless Handheld Vacuum, model BDH2000L. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your new vacuum cleaner. Please read this manual thoroughly before first use and retain it for future reference.

2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Always observe basic safety precautions when using electrical appliances to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock,

- Do not use the appliance to pick up liquids, flammable or combustible materials, or anything that is burning or smoking.
- Do not immerse the appliance in water or other liquids.
- Keep hair, loose clothing, fingers, and all parts of the body away from openings and moving parts.
- Do not operate the appliance if the charger cord or plug is damaged.

3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW AND COMPONENTS

The BDH2000L dustbuster is designed for quick and efficient clean-ups. It features a powerful 20V MAX* lithium-ion battery for strong suction and cordless convenience.

4. SETUP AND CHARGING

Initial Charging:

1. Place the hand vacuum onto the charging dock. Ensure the vacuum is switched to the "OFF" position.
2. Plug the charging dock into a standard electrical outlet.
3. Allow the vacuum to charge for approximately 4 hours for a full charge before first use. The charging indicator light will illuminate during charging.

The charging base provides convenient storage and ensures your vacuum is always ready for use.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Powering On/Off:

To turn the vacuum on, slide the power switch to the "ON" position. To turn it off, slide the switch back to the "OFF" position.

Using Attachments:

- **Rotating Slim Nozzle:** The nozzle can rotate to help you clean tight, hard-to-reach spaces. To rotate, press the button shown in Figure M (from the provided image) and rotate the nozzle to the left or right until it clicks into place.
- **Extendable Crevice Tool:** A crevice tool is built into the nozzle and can be extended for increased reach. Pull the extension piece until it locks into position (refer to Figure K from the provided image).
- **Flip-up Brush:** A brush accessory is built into the nozzle and can be flipped upwards for use (refer to Figure L from the provided image). This is ideal for upholstery and delicate surfaces.

6. MAINTENANCE

Emptying the Dustbowl:

The translucent dustbowl allows you to see when it needs emptying. To empty, simply detach the bowl from the main unit and dispose of the contents. This is a one-touch process for ease of use.

Cleaning the Filter and Dustbowl:

Both the dustbowl and the filter (VF110) are washable. After emptying the dustbowl, you can wash it thoroughly with mild soap and a damp cloth. The filter can also be rinsed under running water. Ensure both are completely dry before reassembling them into the vacuum.

Replacing the Filter:

The filters should be replaced every 6 to 9 months, or whenever they appear worn or damaged. Replacement filters (VF110) are available from BLACK+DECKER dealers. To replace, remove the old filter as described above and fit the new filter into place.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If your product does not work, check the following:

- Ensure the charger is correctly plugged in for recharge. (The charger may feel slightly warm to the touch during operation, which is normal).

- Verify that the charger cord is not damaged and is securely attached.
- Confirm the charger is plugged into a working electrical outlet.
- Make sure the vacuum's switch is in the "OFF" position when charging.

Nozzle / Accessories

- **Figure K** - A crevice tool is built into the nozzle and can be extended as shown in **figure K** by pulling the extension piece until it locks into position.
- **Figure L** - A brush accessory is built into the nozzle and can be flipped upwards for use.
- **Figure M** - The nozzle can be rotated for better access in tight spots. To rotate the nozzle, press the button shown in **figure M** and rotate the nozzle to the left or right until it clicks into place.

Replacing the filters

The filters should be replaced every 6 to 9 months and whenever worn or damaged. Replacement filters are available from your BLACK+DECKER dealer.

Visit www.blackanddecker.com to locate dealers.

- Remove the old filters as described above.
- Fit the new filters as described above.

Maintenance

Bowls and filters can be washed thoroughly; however, use only mild soap and a damp cloth to clean the main part of the vacuum.

IMPORTANT: To assure product SAFETY and RELIABILITY, repairs, maintenance and adjustment (other than those listed in this manual) should be performed by authorized service centers or other qualified service personnel, always using identical replacement parts.

Troubleshooting

If the product does not work, check the following:

- The charger was correctly plugged in for recharge. (It feels slightly warm to the touch.)
- The charger cord is not damaged and is correctly attached.
- The charger is plugged into a working electrical outlet.
- The switch is in the "OFF" position when charging.

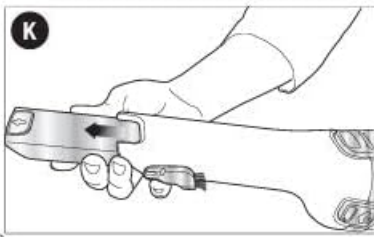
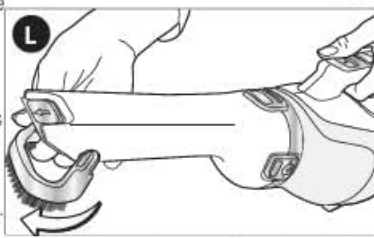
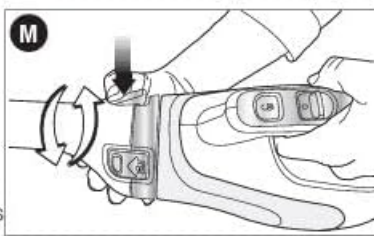




Image 12: Excerpt from the original manual showing instructions for nozzle/accessories (K, L, M), filter replacement, maintenance, and troubleshooting.
