1. Introduction

3. OPERATING YOUR TENNIS BACQUET

The HEAD PCT Titanium ICE Tennis Racquet is designed for playing tennis. Proper technique and handling are crucial for performance and preventing injury.

- **Grip:** Hold the racquet firmly but not too tightly. Experiment with different grip styles to find what is most comfortable and effective for your play.
- Swing Mechanics: Focus on a smooth, controlled swing. The racquet's balance (345 mm unstrung) and

weight (285 gms unstrung) are optimized for a balanced feel.

• **Court Use:** Use the racquet on standard tennis courts. Avoid hitting hard surfaces or objects other than tennis balls to prevent damage.

4. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Regular maintenance will extend the life of your HEAD PCT Titanium ICE Tennis Racquet.

- Cleaning: Wipe the frame with a damp cloth after each use to remove dirt and sweat. Avoid harsh chemicals.
- Grip Care: If the grip becomes worn or slippery, consider replacing the overgrip or the base grip.
- **String Care:** Inspect strings regularly for wear. If strings break or lose tension significantly, professional restringing is recommended.
- **Storage:** Store the racquet in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Using a racquet bag is recommended for protection.




Image: Example of racquet grommets and string guides. These components protect the strings and frame, and may require replacement during restringing.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING COMMON ISSUES

Here are some common issues you might encounter and their potential solutions:

Issue	Possible Cause	Solution
Broken Strings	Normal wear and tear, impact with frame, mishits.	Requires restringing. Consult a professional stringer.
Slippery Grip	Sweat accumulation, worn- out grip material.	Replace the overgrip or the base grip.
Frame Cracks/Dents	Impact with hard surfaces, dropping the racquet.	Severe damage may require racquet replacement. Minor cosmetic damage might not affect play.

Issue	Possible Cause	Solution
Loss of String Tension	Natural string stretching over time, frequent play.	Restringing is necessary to restore playability.
