1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the proper use, care, and maintenance of your COACH HC7003 Kristina Pilot sunglasses. Please read this guide thoroughly to ensure optimal performance and longevity of your eyewear.

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The COACH HC7003 Kristina sunglasses feature a classic Pilot metal frame with durable plastic temples and an adjustable nose bridge for a comfortable fit. The lenses are designed to be lightweight and scratch/impact-resistant.

3. SETUP

Unboxing and Initial Inspection

- Carefully remove the sunglasses from their packaging.
- Inspect the frames and lenses for any signs of damage or manufacturing defects.
- Ensure all accessories, such as the protective case and cleaning cloth, are present.

Adjusting for Fit

- The nose pads are adjustable to provide a comfortable and secure fit on your nose. Gently bend them to conform to your face shape.
- If the temples (arms) feel too tight or too loose, professional adjustment by an optician is recommended to avoid damage.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Wearing Your Sunglasses

- Always use both hands to put on and take off your sunglasses to prevent bending the frames.
- Position the sunglasses so they rest comfortably on your nose and the temples sit securely behind your ears.

Protection from Sunlight

- These sunglasses are designed to reduce glare and protect your eyes from harmful UV rays.
- Do not use these sunglasses for direct observation of the sun or for protection against artificial light sources (e.g., solariums).
- Not suitable for driving at night or in conditions of poor visibility.

5. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Cleaning Your Lenses and Frames

- Use the provided microfiber cleaning cloth to gently wipe away smudges and dust.
- For a more thorough cleaning, rinse the sunglasses under lukewarm water. Apply a small drop of mild soap (avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners) to the lenses and frames.
- Gently rub with your fingertips, then rinse thoroughly and dry with a clean, soft, lint-free cloth.
- Avoid using paper towels or clothing, as these can scratch the lenses.

Storage

- When not in use, always store your sunglasses in their protective case to prevent scratches and damage.
- Avoid leaving sunglasses in direct sunlight or high temperatures (e.g., on a car dashboard), as this can warp the frame and damage lens coatings.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Common Issues and Solutions

- **Loose Screws:** If a screw on the hinge or nose pad becomes loose, gently tighten it with a small eyewear screwdriver. Do not overtighten.
- **Smudged Lenses:** Refer to the "Cleaning Your Lenses and Frames" section for proper cleaning techniques.
- **Uncomfortable Fit:** Adjust the nose pads as described in the "Setup" section. For temple adjustments, consult an optician.
- **Scratched Lenses:** Unfortunately, lens scratches are generally permanent. Proper care and storage are crucial to prevent them.
