



PRODUCT OVERVIEW: CONTROLS AND PORTS

Familiarize yourself with the controls and ports on your BoomBoom 560 headphones:

1 Pause/play **2**Previous 3Next 4Line-in jack **5**Power 6Volume + **7**Volume -**8**USB power 9Microphone R 5

- 1. Pause/Play Button: Controls music playback.
- 2. Previous Track Button: Skips to the previous song.
- 3. Next Track Button: Skips to the next song.
- 4. Line-in Jack: For wired audio connection using the 3.5mm cable.
- 5. Power Button: Turns the headphones on/off and initiates Bluetooth pairing.
- 6. Volume + Button: Increases the volume.
- 7. Volume Button: Decreases the volume.
- 8. **USB Power Port:** For charging the headphones using the Micro USB cable.
- 9. Microphone: Built-in microphone for hands-free calls.

SETUP

1. Charging the Headphones

Before first use, fully charge your headphones. Connect the Micro USB end of the charging cable to the USB Power Port (8) on the headphones and the standard USB end to a USB power adapter (not included) or a computer's USB port. The LED indicator will show charging status. A full charge provides over 8 hours of playback time.

2. Bluetooth Pairing

To connect your headphones wirelessly to a Bluetooth-enabled device:

- 1. Ensure the headphones are turned off.
- 2. Press and hold the **Power Button (5)** until the LED indicator flashes blue and red, indicating pairing mode.
- 3. On your smartphone, tablet, or other Bluetooth device, enable Bluetooth and search for available devices.
- 4. Select "BoomBoom 560" from the list of found devices.
- 5. Once connected, the LED indicator will flash blue slowly.

3. Wired Connection

If Bluetooth is not available or the battery is depleted, you can use the included 3.5mm audio cable. Connect one end of the cable to the **Line-in Jack (4)** on the headphones and the other end to the audio output of your device.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Power On/Off

- To Power On: Press and hold the Power Button (5) for approximately 3 seconds until the LED indicator flashes blue.
- To Power Off: Press and hold the Power Button (5) for approximately 3 seconds until the LED indicator turns off.

Music Playback

- Play/Pause: Press the Pause/Play Button (1) once.
- Next Track: Press the Next Track Button (3) once.
- Previous Track: Press the Previous Track Button (2) once.

Call Management

When connected via Bluetooth, you can manage phone calls using the built-in microphone (9):

- Answer/End Call: Press the Pause/Play Button (1) once.
- Reject Call: Press and hold the Pause/Play Button (1) for approximately 2 seconds.

Volume Control

• Increase Volume: Press the Volume + Button (6).

• Decrease Volume: Press the Volume - Button (7).




Image: A user enjoying music or media with the Marmitek BoomBoom 560 headphones while relaxing at home.

MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your headphones:

- Clean the headphones with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- Avoid exposing the headphones to extreme temperatures, humidity, or direct sunlight.
- Store the headphones in a cool, dry place when not in use.
- Do not attempt to disassemble or repair the headphones yourself, as this will void the warranty.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your BoomBoom 560 headphones, refer to the following common solutions:

- **No Power:** Ensure the headphones are fully charged. Connect them to a power source using the USB charging cable.
- Cannot Pair via Bluetooth:
 - Make sure the headphones are in pairing mode (LED flashing blue and red).
 - Ensure your Bluetooth device's Bluetooth function is enabled and within range (typically 10 meters).
 - Try turning off and on both the headphones and your Bluetooth device.
 - Delete "BoomBoom 560" from your device's Bluetooth list and attempt to pair again.

No Sound:

• Check the volume levels on both the headphones and your connected device.

- Ensure the headphones are properly paired or the 3.5mm audio cable is securely connected.
- · If using Bluetooth, try disconnecting and reconnecting.

• Poor Sound Quality:

- Move closer to your Bluetooth device to reduce interference.
- Ensure there are no obstacles between the headphones and the device.
- Check the audio source for quality issues.
- Loose Earcup Bracket: If the earcup bracket feels loose, handle the headphones with care. Avoid excessive force when adjusting or folding. If the issue persists and affects functionality, contact customer support.
