INTRODUCTION

SETUP

Wrench slips on component.	Incorrect size selected, or wrench not fully seated.	Ensure the correct square drive size is used and fully engaged with the valve stem.
Ratchet mechanism feels stiff or gritty.	Accumulation of dirt or lack of lubrication.	Clean the mechanism and apply a small amount of light machine oil.
Wrench appears bent or damaged.	Excessive force applied or accidental impact.	Discontinue use immediately. Replace the tool to prevent injury or further damage.
