INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for the installation, operation, and maintenance of your Goodman Hepa Media Filter, designed for use with the Goodman DMH900 Air Cleaner. Proper use and timely replacement ensure optimal performance of your air purification system.

SAFETY INFORMATION

Always disconnect power to the air cleaner unit before attempting any installation or maintenance. Wear appropriate personal protective equipment, such as gloves, to prevent skin irritation from dust or filter media. Dispose of used filters according to local regulations.

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps to install or replace the Hepa Media Filter in your Goodman DMH900 Air Cleaner:

1. **Power Disconnection:** Locate the main power switch for your Goodman DMH900 Air Cleaner and turn it off. Ensure the unit is completely powered down before proceeding.
2. **Access Panel Removal:** Open the access panel on your DMH900 Air Cleaner. Refer to your air cleaner's specific manual for instructions on how to safely open this panel.
3. **Old Filter Removal:** Carefully slide out the old Hepa media filter. Note its orientation to ensure the new filter is installed correctly.
4. **New Filter Insertion:** Unpack the new Goodman Hepa Media Filter (DMH40400). Slide the new filter into the air cleaner unit, ensuring it is fully seated and oriented correctly according to the markings on the filter or the air cleaner unit.
5. **Close Access Panel:** Securely close the access panel of the air cleaner.
6. **Power Reconnection:** Restore power to the Goodman DMH900 Air Cleaner.

OPERATION

Once installed, the Goodman Hepa Media Filter operates continuously as part of your DMH900 Air Cleaner system. The filter works by capturing microscopic particles, allergens, and pollutants from the air circulating through your HVAC system, contributing to improved indoor air quality. No specific user interaction is required for the filter's operation beyond proper installation and timely replacement.

MAINTENANCE AND REPLACEMENT

To maintain optimal performance of your Goodman DMH900 Air Cleaner, it is crucial to replace the Hepa Media Filter regularly. The manufacturer recommends replacing the Goodman Hepa Media Filter (DMH40400) every **two years** under normal operating conditions. Factors such as air quality, pet ownership, and system usage may necessitate more frequent replacement.

Replacement Procedure: Follow the "Installation Instructions" outlined in the Setup section to replace the filter.

Disposal: Dispose of the used filter responsibly according to local waste disposal guidelines.

TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues related to the Hepa Media Filter. For issues related to the DMH900 Air Cleaner unit itself, please refer to its specific instruction manual.

- **Reduced Airflow:** If you notice a significant reduction in airflow after installing a new filter, ensure the filter is correctly seated and not obstructed. A heavily soiled filter can also restrict airflow; if the filter is old, consider replacing it.
- **Persistent Odors or Allergens:** If air quality does not improve or odors persist after filter replacement, verify that the filter is the correct type and size for your DMH900 unit. Ensure the air cleaner unit itself is functioning correctly.
- **Filter Indicator Light (if applicable):** If your DMH900 Air Cleaner has a filter indicator light, consult your air cleaner's manual for instructions on how to reset it after filter replacement.
