The information contained herein covers the standard features and options available for the 2011 Chevrolet Aveo. Specific features may vary based on your vehicle's trim level and optional equipment.

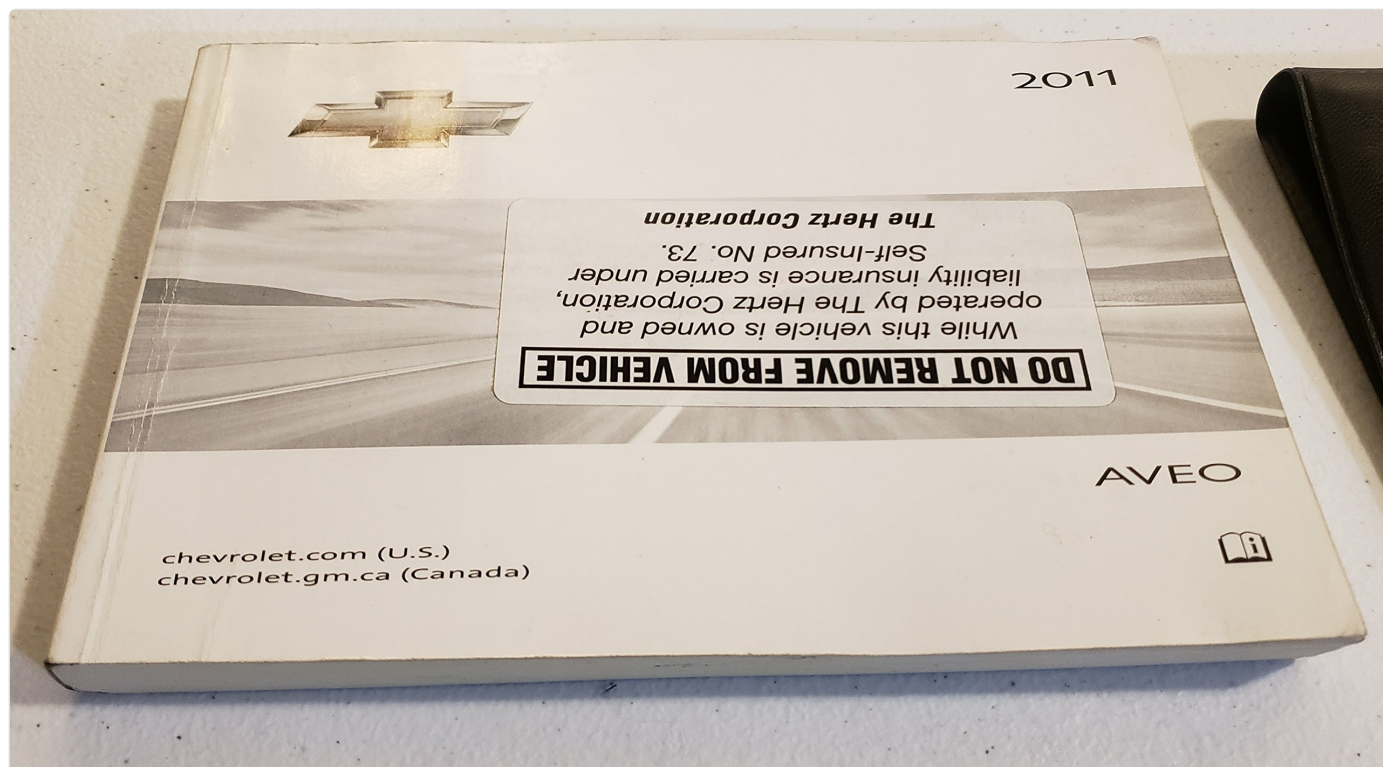


Figure 1: Front cover of the 2011 Chevrolet Aveo Owner's Manual. The manual displays the year "2011" and the model "AVEO". A prominent label states "DO NOT REMOVE FROM VEHICLE", indicating it might have been part of a rental fleet, specifically mentioning "The Hertz Corporation". Contact information for "chevrolet.com (U.S.)" and "chevrolet.gm.ca (Canada)" is also visible. Below the manual is a black leather-like folder with an embossed Chevrolet logo.

GETTING STARTED: INITIAL SETUP AND CONTROLS

Before driving your 2011 Chevrolet Aveo, it is essential to familiarize yourself with the basic controls and safety features. This section covers initial adjustments and key components.

Vehicle Entry and Seating

VEHICLE OPERATION

Starting the Engine

1. Ensure the transmission is in Park (P) for automatic or Neutral (N) for manual.

Driving Your Aveo

- **Manual Transmission:** Use the clutch pedal and gear shifter to select appropriate gears. Start in first gear and shift up as speed increases.
- **Braking:** Apply steady pressure to the brake pedal to slow down or stop. Avoid sudden braking unless necessary.
- **Parking Brake:** Engage the parking brake when parking the vehicle, especially on inclines. Disengage it before driving.

Infotainment and Comfort Features

- **Radio/CD Player:** Refer to the specific instructions for your audio system to operate the radio, CD player, and auxiliary inputs.
- **Power Windows:** Use the switches on the door panels to raise and lower the windows.

- **Central Locking:** Use the central locking button on the door or dashboard to lock/unlock all doors simultaneously.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Routine Checks
