Tupperware Deviled Egg Trays Instruction Manual

MODEL: TUP-ERG-TRAY-0001

Introduction

This manual provides instructions for the proper use and care of your Tupperware Deviled Egg Trays. These trays are designed to securely hold deviled eggs and fit specifically within a Tupperware Large Cold Cut Keeper Snack N Stor Container or Deli Keeper. Each set includes three trays, offering a total capacity for up to 2 dozen deviled eggs.

Product Features

- **Compatibility:** Designed to fit Tupperware Large Cold Cut Keeper Snack N Stor Container or Deli Keeper.
- **Capacity:** Each tray holds up to 8 deviled eggs, accommodating a total of up to 24 eggs (2 dozen) per set of three trays.
- **Material:** Durable plastic construction.
- **Care:** Dishwasher safe for easy cleaning.

Setup

Before first use, wash the deviled egg trays with warm, soapy water or place them in the dishwasher. Ensure they are completely dry before placing eggs or storing them.

To set up for use:

1. Ensure the trays are clean and dry.
2. Prepare your deviled eggs according to your recipe.
3. Carefully place one deviled egg into each designated cavity on the tray. Each tray has 8 cavities.
4. Once filled, place the trays into your Tupperware Large Cold Cut Keeper Snack N Stor Container or

Deli Keeper for transport or storage. The trays are designed to stack neatly within these containers.

Operating Instructions

The Tupperware Deviled Egg Trays are designed for simple and secure egg storage.

- **Filling:** After preparing your deviled eggs, gently place each egg half into a cavity on the tray. The cavities are shaped to cradle the eggs, preventing them from shifting during transport.
- **Storage:** Once the trays are filled, place them inside a compatible Tupperware container (Large Cold Cut Keeper Snack N Stor Container or Deli Keeper). This provides an airtight seal, helping to keep your deviled eggs fresh.
- **Serving:** To serve, carefully lift the trays from the container. You can serve directly from the trays or transfer the eggs to a serving platter. When removing eggs from the trays, use a small spoon or spatula to gently lift them to maintain their appearance.

Maintenance and Care

Proper care ensures the longevity of your Tupperware Deviled Egg Trays.

- **Cleaning:** The trays are dishwasher safe. For best results, place them on the top rack of your dishwasher. Alternatively, wash by hand with warm water and mild dish soap. Rinse thoroughly and allow to air dry or dry with a soft cloth.
- **Temperature Restrictions:**
 - **Not Freezer Safe:** Do not place these trays in the freezer, as extreme cold can cause the plastic to become brittle and crack.
 - **Not Microwave Safe:** Do not use these trays in a microwave oven.
 - **Not Oven Safe:** Do not place these trays in a conventional oven.
- **Storage:** Store trays in a clean, dry place when not in use.

Troubleshooting

Issue	Possible Cause	Solution
Difficulty lifting deviled eggs from cavities	Eggs may be stuck due to filling consistency or tray design.	Use a small, thin spoon or a narrow spatula to gently pry the egg from the cavity. Avoid using sharp objects that could scratch the tray.
Trays do not fit in container	Container may not be a compatible Tupperware Large Cold Cut Keeper Snack N Stor Container or Deli Keeper.	Ensure you are using the correct Tupperware container model as specified for these trays.
