INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps to properly install your new Delfield Refrigeration Door Gasket 1702622:

- 1. Preparation:** Ensure the refrigeration unit is powered off and unplugged from the electrical outlet. Clear the area around the door to allow for easy access.
- 2. Remove Old Gasket:** Carefully pull the old gasket from its retaining channel around the perimeter of the refrigerator door. Observe how the old gasket was seated to assist with the installation of the new one.
- 3. Clean Channel:** Thoroughly clean the gasket retaining channel on the refrigerator door. Remove any debris, food particles, or old adhesive residue that could prevent a proper seal.
- 4. Install New Gasket:** Begin by pressing one corner of the new Delfield 1702622 gasket firmly into the retaining channel. Work your way around the door, pressing the gasket bead into the channel until it is fully seated. Ensure the gasket is not twisted or stretched during installation.
- 5. Check Seal:** Close the refrigerator door and check for a proper seal. A common method is the dollar bill test: close the door on a dollar bill, then try to pull it out. If there is resistance, the seal is good. Repeat this test around the entire door perimeter.
- 6. Final Adjustment:** If the gasket does not seal properly in certain areas, gently warm the gasket with a hairdryer on a low setting to make it more pliable, then press it firmly into place. Allow it to cool and re-check the seal.

7. **Restore Power:** Once the gasket is securely installed and sealing correctly, plug in and power on the refrigeration unit.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance of your Delfield Refrigeration Door Gasket 1702622 will extend its lifespan and maintain optimal refrigeration performance.

- **Cleaning:** Clean the gasket regularly with mild soap and warm water. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners, as these can damage the gasket material and compromise its sealing ability.
- **Inspection:** Periodically inspect the gasket for signs of wear, tears, cracks, hardening, or mold growth. A damaged or deteriorated gasket can lead to air leaks, increased energy consumption, and potential food spoilage.
- **Alignment:** Ensure the refrigerator door hinges are properly aligned. Misaligned hinges can cause uneven pressure on the gasket, leading to premature wear and an ineffective seal.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you experience issues with your Delfield Refrigeration Door Gasket 1702622, consider the following common problems and solutions:

- **Poor Seal / Air Leaks:**
 - **Cause:** Gasket not fully seated, twisted, or damaged; door hinges misaligned; gasket hardened.
 - **Solution:** Re-seat the gasket firmly into its channel, check for twists, inspect for damage and replace if necessary. Adjust door hinges if they are causing uneven pressure. Gently warm the gasket with a hairdryer to restore flexibility.
- **Condensation Around Door:**
 - **Cause:** Ineffective seal allowing warm, moist air to enter the refrigeration unit.
 - **Solution:** Follow the steps for "Poor Seal / Air Leaks". Ensure the gasket is clean and free of any debris that might prevent a complete seal.
- **Increased Energy Consumption:**
 - **Cause:** The refrigeration unit is working harder than necessary due to air leaks from a faulty gasket, leading to higher energy bills.
 - **Solution:** Inspect the gasket thoroughly for any signs of damage or poor sealing. Replace the gasket if it is not providing an effective seal.
