INTRODUCTION

The Laco 1925 Pilot Classic Automatic Watch, Model 861688, is a precision timepiece designed for reliability and clear readability. This manual provides essential information for the proper setup, operation, and maintenance of your watch, ensuring its longevity and accurate performance.

SETUP

Unboxing and Initial Winding

Your Laco watch comes securely packaged. Carefully remove the watch from its protective case. To initiate the automatic movement, gently shake the watch for a few seconds or manually wind it by rotating the crown clockwise approximately 20-30 times. The watch will then begin to operate.

Setting the Time

To set the time, pull the crown out to its outermost position. Rotate the crown to adjust the hour and minute hands to the correct time. Once set, push the crown back in to its original position to engage the movement.

OPERATING YOUR LACO WATCH

Automatic Movement

This watch features an automatic movement, which is powered by the natural motion of your wrist. Regular wear will keep the watch wound. If the watch is not worn for an extended period, it may stop and require manual winding or gentle shaking to restart.

Time Adjustment

The crown on the side of the watch is used for setting the time. Pull it out to adjust the hands and push it back in to start the movement. Ensure the crown is fully pushed in to maintain water resistance.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Water Resistance

The Laco 1925 Pilot Classic watch is water resistant up to 5 ATM (50 meters / 165 feet). This rating makes it suitable for short periods of recreational swimming, but it is not designed for diving or snorkeling. Avoid operating the crown while the watch is wet or submerged to prevent water intrusion.

Strap Care

The brown calf leather strap should be kept dry and clean. Avoid prolonged exposure to water, direct sunlight, or harsh chemicals to preserve its quality and extend its lifespan. Clean the strap with a soft, damp cloth as needed.

Crystal Care

The watch features a durable sapphire crystal, known for its scratch resistance. To clean, gently wipe the crystal with a soft, lint-free cloth. Avoid using abrasive materials or harsh cleaning agents.

Movement Care

For optimal performance and longevity, it is recommended to have your automatic watch serviced by a qualified watchmaker every few years. This ensures the internal components are clean, lubricated, and functioning correctly.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Time Inaccuracy

If your watch is not keeping accurate time, ensure it is sufficiently wound. Automatic watches require consistent movement or manual winding if not worn daily. If the issue persists after ensuring proper winding, professional inspection by a qualified watchmaker may be required to diagnose and correct any internal movement issues.
